International Day of The Girl Child Report

The Department of Political Science in collaboration with Unnat Bharat Abhiyan cell, St. Xavier's college, celebrated the International Day of the Girl Child on October 11th, 2023, at Sunder Public Senior Secondary School and associate institutions of Mahapura Gram Panchayat.

The celebration theme was **“Our time is now - Our right, our Future”**. The students of Political Science delivered self-defence training to the school and college students under the UBA umbrella.

Aneen Alvi from the Department of English and Molly Bhargav from the Department of Political Science were the trainers for the day. Approx 150 girl students attended the session and actively participated in learning and using self-defence techniques during emergencies. Along with this training session, the Department of Political Science also organised a poster-making competition and slogan-writing competition for all school students.

St. Xaviers College Jaipur provided blank sheets for posters and slogans. Around 60 students participated in this competition. The results of the competition were declared by the panel of teachers associated with Sunder Public Senior Secondary School and prizes were distributed by the college management.

All the students were very enthusiastic about learning self-defence techniques. Even after the demonstration, they tried to repeat all the techniques our trainer Anin Alvi taught.
