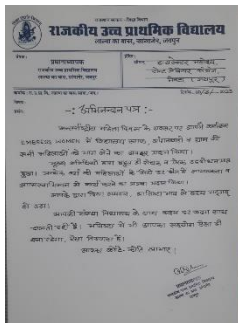
3. Objective: *(Key objectives of organizing events/programs/ work performed in the last academic year in points only)*
