# Initiatives Under Sustainable Development Goals Rainwater Harvesting

The availability of clean underground water is declining at a very fast rate resulting in unsustainable levels of exploitation. Water, being one of the five essential elements for the sustenance of life, is unevenly available across the country. Underground water remains the preferred source for domestic and agricultural purposes and hence, its extraction along with recharging and harvesting should be optimized. A recent study published in Geophysical Research Letters revealed that the excessive extraction of groundwater has shifted the Earth's axis of rotation at the rate of 4.36 cm per year towards the east. Our college is profoundly concerned about local and national issues and plays a key role in addressing such issues. To contribute in achieving the SDG 6 set by the United Nations, rainwater is collected in a tank of capacity 80 thousands liters and this water is utilised in watering of plants, fields, cleaning etc.



#### **Solar Power Station**

ur college took an initiative to contribute in achieving the targets of SDG-7 and a 300 kWh on-grid solar power station was commissioned in May 2023. The average coal consumed in producing 1.0 unit of electricity ranges 0.69 - 0.89 kg and it produces roughly 2.0 kg of CO<sub>2</sub>. Thus, utilisation of clean solar energy for the generation of electricity is least polluting and helps in reducing the emission of CO<sub>2</sub> significantly.



# **Bio-Composting of Organic Waste**

The department of science consciously working on composting biodegradable waste that can reduce negetive impact of climate change while also recycling nutrients. Keeping this thought in mind college campus had initiated an eco-conscious venture, employing bio

composting – a microbialdriven process transforming organic waste into nutrientrich compost for gardening and agriculture. This initiative centers on curbing solid waste, promoting resource reuse, and championing environmental preservation which aligns with SDG-13. The goal is to use microbial power to convert waste into valuable compost, promoting soil enrichment and



sustainability in an effort to adopt greener methods.

# Vermicomposting Implementation

The Department of Science at St. Xavier's College Jaipur had initiated an impactful vermicomposting unit in the college as part of SDG-13. This sustainable endeavour aims to convert organic waste into nutrient-rich compost

through earthwormdriven processes. The project not only creates high-quality compost but also fosters a publicprivate relationship by offering affordable compost to the local residents. The students



have been benefitted by learning the process of vermicomposting while the college utilizes the produced compost for on-campus plantations, contributing to a greener environment. The proactive efforts of the management and expertise of the member of the department have been instrumental in the successful establishment of this ecofriendly initiative.



















Biodiversity refers to all forms of life on earth that provide the core benefits, which humans derive from the environment viz. food, air, water security, and other natural benefits. Plants define the habitat of a site, providing structure, shelter and food as well as contributing to the overall biodiversity. Plants include trees, shrubs, grasses and herbaceous plants. To contribute to the global targets (SDG-15) set by the United Nations, our college has taken several initiatives to protect, restore and promote sustainable development. In our college campus, more than 120 plant species are cultivated and nearly 4000 plants in total are sustained. The 120 plant species are characterized into medicinal, forest, ornamental and fruit plants. Our college is a Green Campus where environment-friendly practices theoretically learnt in classrooms seamlessly merge with practical aspects of daily life not only to encourage sustainable and environmental-friendly practices at our college campus but also inspire students to adapt them in their personal lives. The green campus concept provides an opportunity for an institution to lead the way in re-imagining its environment and redefine paradigms through the development of sustainable solutions to meet humanity's environmental, social, and economic needs.

#### Ayush Udhyan

eeping in mind SDG-03 Aherbal garden namely 'Ayush Udhyan' has been established in St. Xavier's College Jaipur near gate number 02. Different herbal plants such as Veld Grape (*Cissus quadrangularis*), Gale of the Wind (*Phyllanthus niuri*), Holy Basil (*Ocimum sanctum*), Aloe Vera, Madagascar Periwinkle (*Catharanthus roseus*), Cathedral Bells (*Bryophyllum pinnatum*), Giloy



(*Tinospora cordifolia*), Kalmegh (*Andrographis paniculata*) are planted. This herbal garden will be opened for local people to collect required herbs. Other medicinal plants will also be planted soon on our campus.

# Xavier's Open Gym

The 'Xavier's Open Gym' was inaugurated on 17 November 2023, by Ms. Surbhi Misra, an acclaimed International Squash Player and Maharana Pratap Awardee, at the Loyola Garden. Ms. Misra, the Chief Guest, emphasized the fusion of physical fitness and mental well-

being, urging youth to participate in sports for promising careers. The Open Gym, aims at fostering a healthconscious environment as part of SDG-03.



## **Establishment of an E-Waste Collection Center**

The National Green Corps - Eco Club, in collaboration with the Swachhta Action Plan, inaugurated an E-Waste Collection Centre within the college campus with SDG-13 in mind. Eight designated bins facilitate for the disposal of various e-waste categories. GPS International, an E-Waste Management Company based in Jaipur, partnered with us to oversee this initiative. Bins are allocated for specific components like PCB, MB, mobiles, and more, including metallic items such as HDD, electric appliances, and burnt electronics.



# **Transportation and Carpooling System to Minimise Carbon Footprint**








#### SDG 4 : Quality Education

Society, and students from the two village schools, adopted under the **UBA** scheme were part of the celebrations.
















The Consumers' Society in collaboration with Xavier's Fintech Commerce Society organized an event 'Lecture on Awareness
