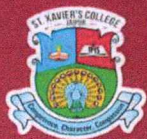

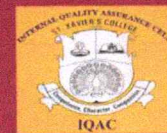

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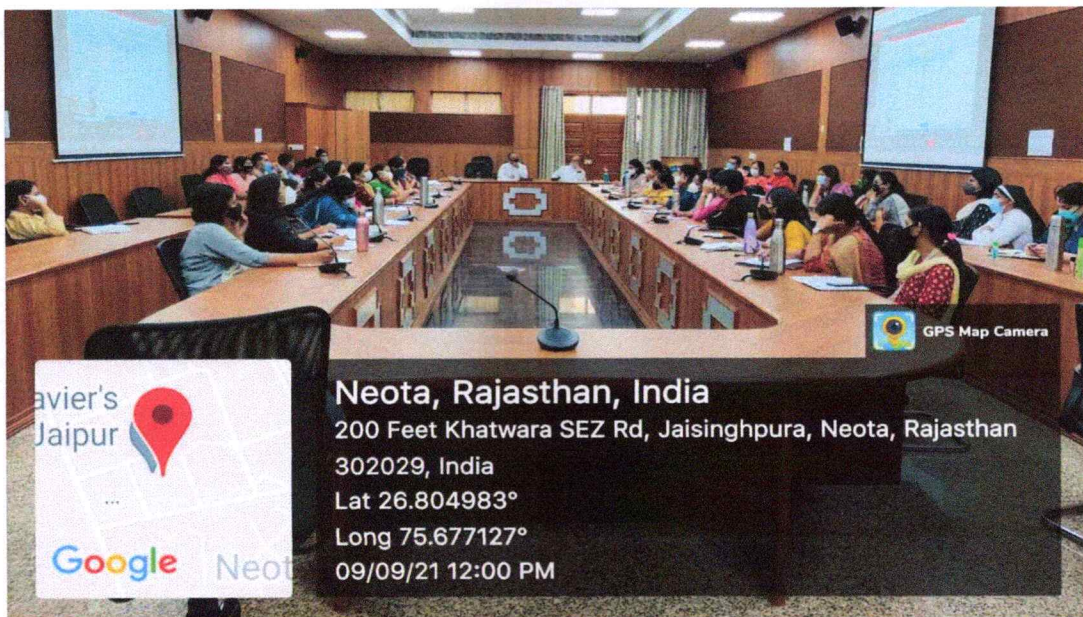
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renowned organizations to facilitate exchange programs for both students and faculty. This will foster cultural diversity and create a richer learning environment for all.
