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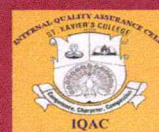

Brief Report:	A Two-day Lecture was organized by the Department of English of St. Xavier's College, Jaipur on "Writing Research Papers" on 7 and 8 September 2020. The Resource person for the lecture series was Prof. Rajul Bhargava, Former Head, Department of English, University of Rajasthan, Jaipur. Prof Bhargava introduced the students to the art of writing research papers. She elaborated on the evolution and significance of research in contemporary times. She emphasized on the structure of the paper, the art of framing an apt title, writing abstract and selecting an appropriate theoretical framework while writing a research paper. The second day of the lecture focused on the citations and use of MLA 8th Edition. Prof. Bhargava discussed in detail how it deviates from the earlier editions and discussed the format for citations with relevant examples. The session ended with a Q & A session where the students and faculty members deliberated on issues related to the use of theories, structure of the paper and citations. A more detailed webinar or a workshop was suggested in the feedback thus received that would go into greater detail covering the fine nuances of writing Research Papers.
Outcome:	This lecture series offered a valuable introduction to research paper writing, equipping students with essential knowledge and skills. Addressing the suggestions for increased depth and practical application can further strengthen future sessions.

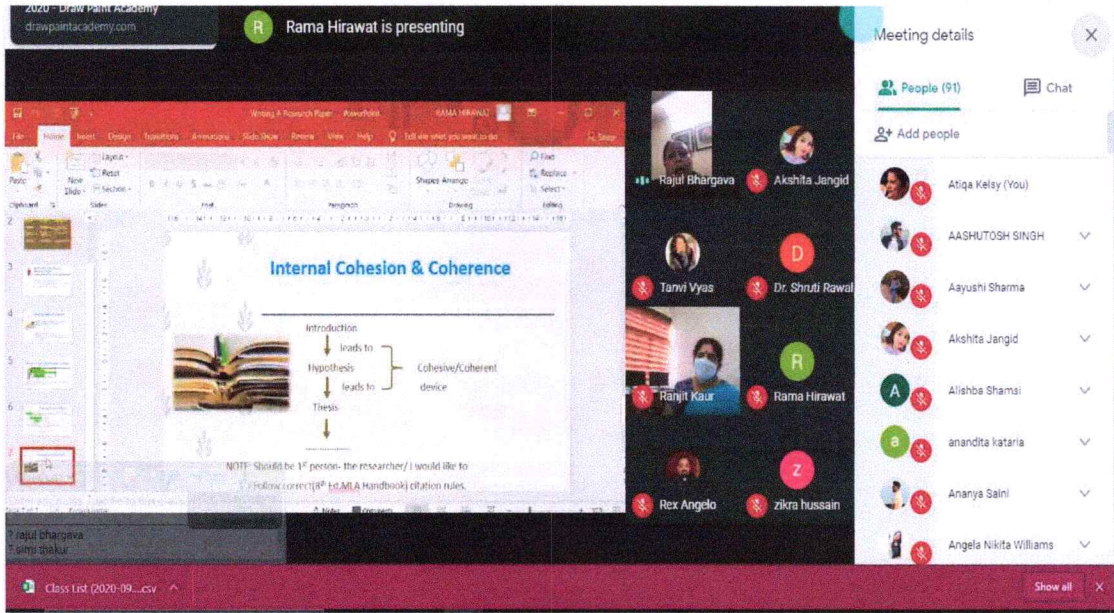

Brief Report:	The Department of Computer Science, under the aegis of IQAC and in collaboration with Xavier's Research Project Cell, organized a Short-Term Training Program (STTP) on Data Science using R programming from October 19-24, 2020. The resource persons were Dr. Brijesh Awasthi, Adjunct Professor (Data Analytics and Research) at Poornima University and Jaipuria Institute of Management. 20 students from the BCA program participated in this intensive program. The STTP began by introducing participants to the fundamentals of statistical data analysis through engaging examples and highlighting its importance in research and development. Dr. Awasthi then emphasized the need to enhance data analytical skills using R programming. Through hands-on sessions in RStudio, participants gained confidence working with advanced techniques for data quantification, data frame manipulation, and retrieval.
Outcome:	Feedback from participants was highly positive, praising the program's structure, hands-on approach, and Dr. Awasthi's expertise. Many expressed a desire for further training in specific areas of data science.

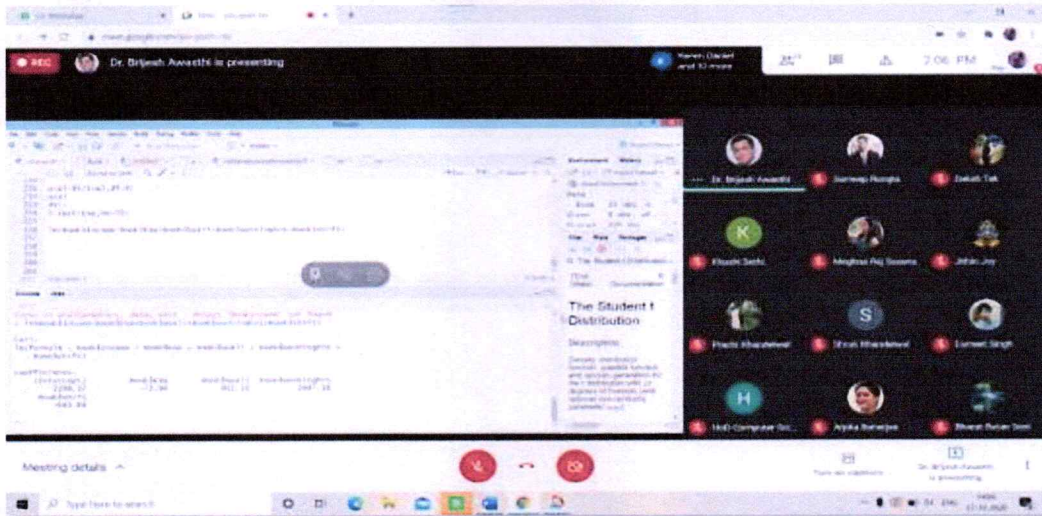

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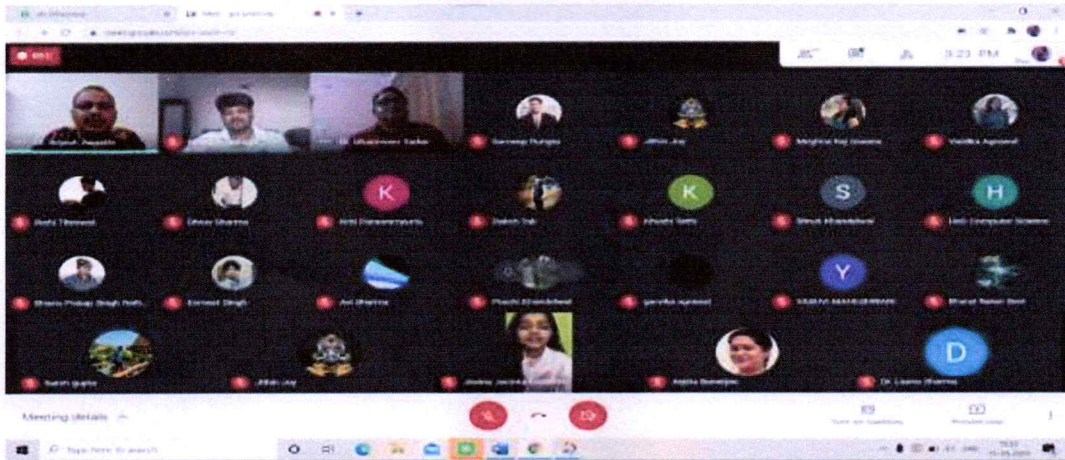

ABOUT THE SYMPOSIUM

What determines the endurance and relevance of a field of art is its capability to captivate and its ability to morph itself with changing times. Literature has, for this very reason, been an ever powerful form of art that has never lost its relevance. Human beings have an innate need to tell stories, perhaps it helps us to cope with reality, to accept the ups and downs of our lives, or maybe to make sense of it all.

With the COVID pandemic becoming a major checkpoint of world history, changing and affecting innumerable lives, the time is ripe to take a look at how literature, the expression of experiences, has changed forms dynamically, all the while not diminishing the original form, i.e., books. Right from the ancient forms transforming themselves (such as ballads to theatre), to the modern forms transforming at a rapid pace (from reel to digital media), there are instances shown throughout decades that testify to the changing forms of literature and how it has been brought closer to the general reader. From Xaki Saramelino - considered elitist and rigid - to Poetry Slams - that aim to become more flexible and approachable - the transformations are quite evident, bringing spoken poetry to the forefront of self-expression. Plays based on history - like Hamilton - have made theatre more relatable and popular. And these changes aren't limited to the forms of poetry or theatricalism. Writers like Alan Moore - with his graphic novels such as *From Hell* - are bringing the Victorian Era to the twenty-first century, along with movie adaptations of novels - such as the masterpiece *The Lord of The Rings* - nowadays series adaptations have also come into vogue, allowing the written work more space and time on the visual platform - few noteworthy examples include the recent adaptations of Vikram Seth's *A Suitable Boy* and *The Hating of My Mother* based on Henry James's *The Turn of the Screw*. Apart from transposition of books into visual media, there are novels that are based on historical accounts, such as Jack Kerouac's *The City Next Door*, Stephen King's *11/22/63* and Alex Greiner's *The Flood* (giving the readers knowledge not only about sensational topics and events, but also a look into the historical era, increasing the readers' perception of the world and its history).

The National Symposium, on Changing Dimensions of Literature invites researchers to share their novel thoughts and researches on these metamorphoses, and thus broaden viewpoints and perspectives in a time when it is only through literature that our society, and indeed our world, can gain the strength to enter a new era with a more understanding and thoughtful outlook.

To explore more of such consequences in every aspect of life and our survival, St Xavier's College organised this international conference linking academicians, industrialists, and students across the globe through online platform.</p> <p>The theme and sub themes that are covered in this conference cut across boundaries and talk of an integrated approach to this global crisis to allow dialogue. The conference was inaugurated on Google Meet connecting academics, scholars, researchers, and entrepreneurs across the globe. Rev. Fr. Varkey Perekatt, Manager, St. Xavier's College, Jaipur, applauded the initiative of the college in holding a conference on a current challenge that calls upon our collective will and strength as a fight back mechanism. Rev. Dr. Fr. A Rex Angelo, our erudite Principal, stressed on the need of every individual turning into a Corona Warrior. By sharing the real-life story of a boy who cycled from Kerala to Kashmir selling tea during the pandemic, he highlighted how every spoke in the wheel of humanity is vital for our collective survival and how every positive stroke is valuable in dark times as these, no matter how small a ripple it may seem.</p> <p>The chief guest, Dr. Nassir Nasser, Associate Executive Dean, Computer Information Science Division, HCT, UAE, in his address appreciated the adaptability of the human spirit yet cautioned us at the same time. While laying out a roadmap for future he raised red flags to</p>



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slow down our eagerness in leaving conventional and time-tested models for the more attractive and lucrative options. He insisted on maintaining a mindful balance if we are to sustain ourselves in the face of such crises.

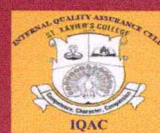

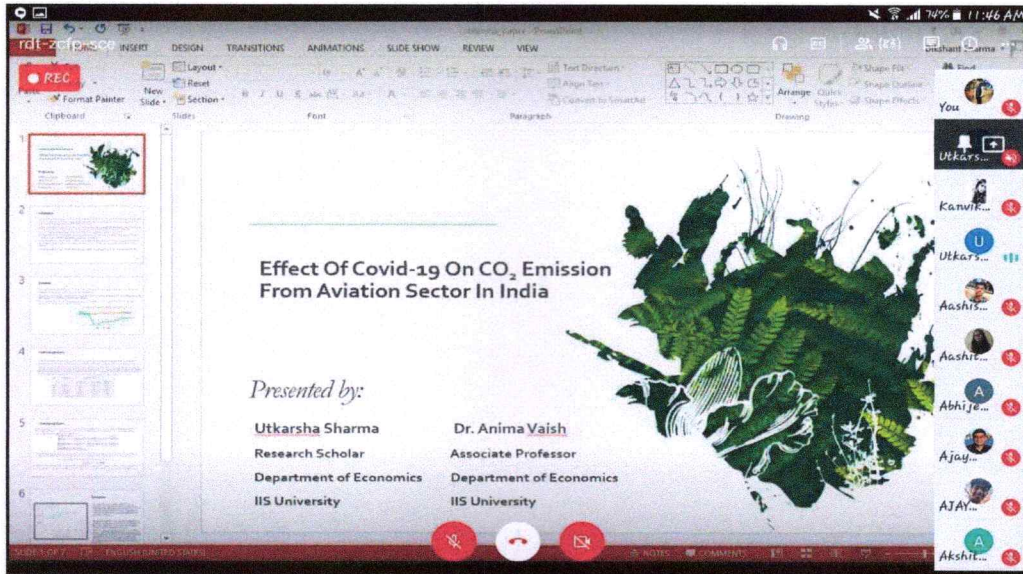

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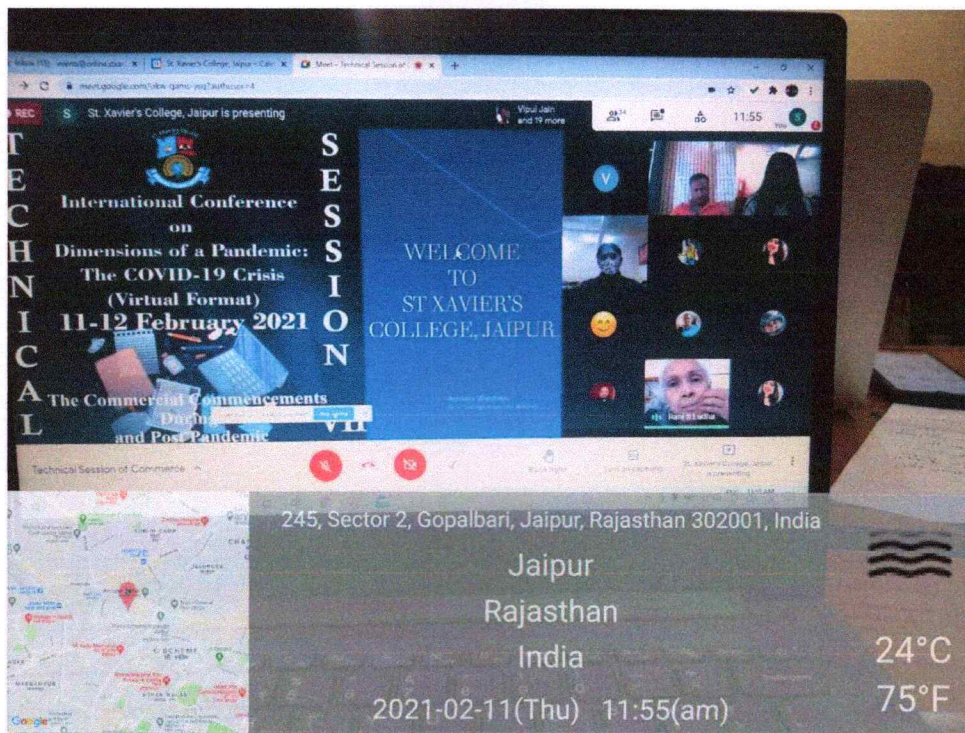
