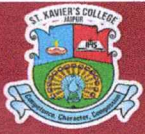

- **Monitoring and Evaluation:** It regularly monitors and evaluates the effectiveness of implemented strategies and activities related to cleanliness.

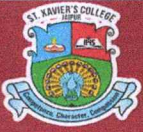
#### Impact of Swachhta Action Plan (SAP) in neighborhood community:
