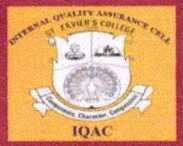

FEEDBACK REPORT: BOOK REVIEW "THE SILENT PATIENT"

The Xavier's Intellectual Forum (XIF) held its first offline open-group book review of *The Silent Patient* by Alex Michaelides in the Girls Student Lounge. The book is a 2019 psychological thriller that not only featured as a bestseller in New York Times but was critically appreciated as well. The novel is narrated by an English psychotherapist, Theo Faber and revolves around a patient who turns mute after murdering her husband. The different aspects of the books from the thematic perspective and the techniques were discussed by the students. The portrayal of the characters, effectiveness of the writing style and the depiction of human nature was also deliberated by the members. The session was moderated by Vasudha Sharma. The session concluded with remarks from Dr Shruti Rawal who shared the nuances of reviewing a work with the students.

FEEDBACK REPORT: ENRICHMENT LECTURE ON POST-COLONIALISM

On 2 September 2021, the Department of English at St. Xavier's College - Jaipur organized a Guest Lecture on **Postcolonialism – An Introduction** through the virtual gateway. Postcolonialism is one of the most substantive and debated topics in the realm of English Literature. Nothing could have been more enriching than organizing a Guest Address on this theme by **Prof Pramod K. Nayar**. Prof Nayar is the Professor – Department of English at the University of Hyderabad with more than 103 publications and has countless feathers in his cap. His bailiwick is Colonial Writings in English, and he is one of those speakers who can combine the deftness of subject-knowledge with real-life examples. During his one-hour session, he mesmerized the participants with his prudent, convincing, well-presented know-how about the topic without any postmodernist jargon. He also dispelled certain preconceived myths regarding concepts such as the difference between the Study of Colonial Discourse v/s Post-Colonial Literature and Culture, who is the Colonizer, and who is colonized? By quoting examples of exemplary writers and figures like Edward Said, M.K. Gandhi and S. Nagarajan, he made the interaction upbeat and *au fait*. His astounding inputs to Postcolonialism and associative terms were very insightful and enlightening to all our participants. The session concluded with a series of highly interactive questions and answers with the speaker. It was indeed a great learning and growing session for all of us.

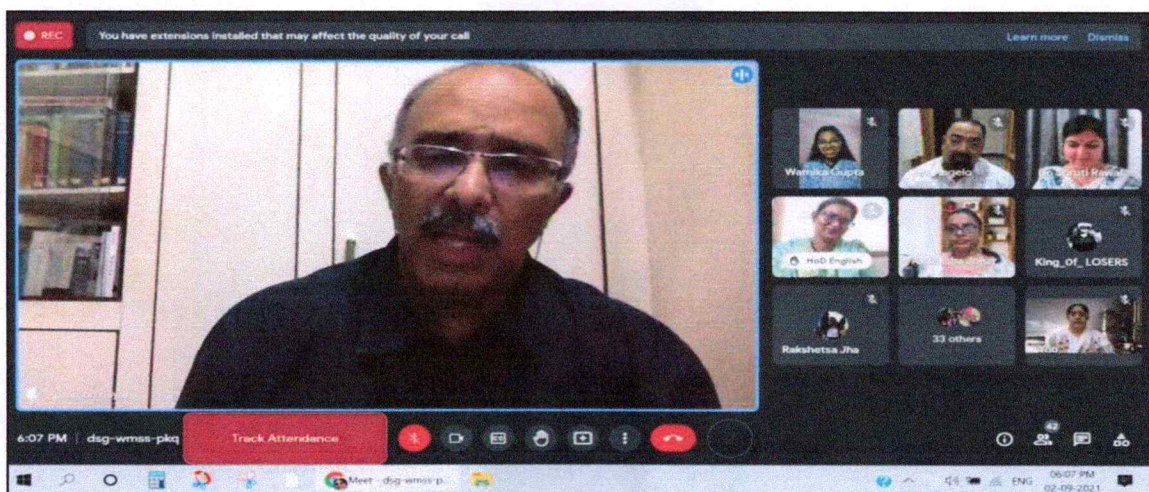
REPORT: ENRICHMENT LECTURE ON POST-COLONIALISM

On September 2, 2021, the Department of English at St. Xavier's College, Jaipur, hosted a virtual guest lecture titled "Postcolonialism – An Introduction," delivered by the distinguished Prof. Pramod K. Nayar from the University of Hyderabad. Prof. Nayar, who boasts over 103 publications and a profound expertise in Colonial Writings in English, provided an engaging and insightful discourse on this critical and debated area in English literature.

Throughout the hour-long session, Prof. Nayar eloquently demystified complex postcolonial concepts using relatable real-life examples, steering clear of dense postmodernist jargon. His discussion focused on clarifying common misconceptions, such as the distinctions between Colonial Discourse Studies and Post-Colonial Literature and Culture, and addressing fundamental questions about the identities of the colonizer versus the colonized. He enriched the lecture by referencing seminal figures and writers including Edward Said, M.K. Gandhi, and S. Nagarajan, which added depth and context to his explanations.

The lecture not only illuminated various aspects of postcolonial studies but also spurred an enthusiastic interaction during the Q&A session, reflecting the participants' engagement and newly sparked interests. Prof. Nayar's ability to connect theoretical insights with practical implications made the lecture exceptionally beneficial for students and faculty alike, marking it as a significant educational experience for all attendees.
