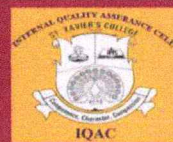

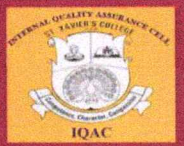


REPORT: INDUSTRIAL VISIT TO CLAY CRAFT

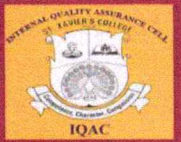
KRITESH AGARWAL
