EVENT 3 Ms. Laxmi Agarwal- Acid Attack Survivor

PROFILE

Laxmi Agarwal is a prominent Indian campaigner known for her relentless advocacy against acid attacks and her role as a television host. In 2005, Laxmi Agarwal endured a horrific acid attack that left her with severe injuries and scars, altering the course of her life forever. Despite the immense physical and emotional pain she endured, Agarwal refused to be defined by the cruelty inflicted upon her. Instead, she emerged as a beacon of strength and resilience, determined to turn her personal tragedy into a catalyst for change.

Agarwal became a vocal advocate for the rights of acid attack survivors, raising awareness about the heinous crime and tirelessly campaigning for stricter laws and greater support for victims. Through her courageous efforts, she brought attention to the plight of survivors and challenged societal perceptions surrounding beauty and gender-based violence.


In addition to her advocacy work, Agarwal is the director of the Chhanv Foundation, a nongovernmental organization dedicated to providing support and rehabilitation services to survivors of acid attacks. Through the foundation, she has helped countless individuals rebuild their lives and regain their confidence after enduring unimaginable trauma.

Beyond her activism, Agarwal is also known for her work as a television host, using her platform to amplify the voices of survivors and continue her mission of spreading awareness and inspiring change.

EVENT 5 Mr. Devendra Raj Mehta


PROFILE




