Brief Report:

The Department of Political Science, St. Xavier's College, Jaipur in collaboration with the Network of Asia Pacific Schools and Institutes of Public Administration and Governance Disaster Research Group (NDRG), an Asia-Pacific academic, research and networking organization that works in the area of governance and policy analysis, organized a Certificate Course on the 'Fundamentals of Public Policy'. The course was held online from October 18th, 2021-November 25th, 2021. The lectures included 30 hours of designated teaching and was open for undergraduate students. It was joined by over 51 students of prestigious institutions, across the country that included Central University of Kerala, Central University of Gujarat, Kamala Nehru college for women, Jawaharlal Nehru University, Miranda House and Rayburn college.

The key objective of this certificate course was to deepen students' understanding of how public policy is made. It was aimed at training the students in various aspects of policymaking so that they may be able to provide innovative solutions to the most critical issues facing Indian society. The course covered both theoretical and practical aspects of public policy. It also covered a detailed analysis of key concepts alongside approaches and goals of public policy in the present era. It attempted to develop a deep understanding of all stages of policy formulation, evaluation and execution of public policy so that students can develop the skills to communicate policy advice both verbally and in writing.

The course commenced on October 18, 2021, with an Orientation-cum-Introduction program that was organized to welcome the students and to familiarize the students with the faculty, teaching program and course schedule. The orientation program provided the students with relevant information about the course structure, teaching and evaluation methods.

Feedback Report: In the certificate course, the students underwent through a rigorous system of evaluation and assessment. The students were asked to write a Monograph on the understanding of the theoretical models and approaches that are used for understanding the various dimensions of public policy. The students were then asked to make presentations and defend their analysis. The monograph and assignment and presentation was of 10 marks each
