Brief Report:	<p>The Department of Computer Science at St. Xavier's College Jaipur organized a Robotics Workshop as a pre-event for our departmental fest, Technoid, held on November 5th, 2019. The workshop garnered 46 registrations and was deemed a success. Students participated in teams of 4-5 members each. The workshop was conducted in collaboration with TechieNest, a company specializing in workshops, R&D, training, automations, and project solutions. The workshop fee was Rs 500 per student, with the college subsidizing Rs 100 per student. The workshop spanned 6 hours, during which participants were instructed in Arduino board coding, facilitated by equipment provided by TechieNest. Students were required to bring their own laptops for the coding exercises. Additionally, the workshop offered an opportunity for the top 3 teams to advance to the finals of the All-India Research Competition (AIRC) scheduled for March 2020 at IIT Kanpur. These teams were selected through a competition held immediately after the workshop. To qualify for the finals, the chosen teams must submit another robotics project, with the chance of representing the college at IIT Kanpur contingent upon the acceptance of their project.</p>
Feedback Report:	<p>The feedback from students regarding the robotics workshop was overwhelmingly positive. Some common observations were :</p> <p>Engaging and Interactive: Students appreciated the hands-on nature of the workshop, finding it highly engaging and interactive. They enjoyed the opportunity to work with actual hardware and coding environments.</p> <p>Knowledge Enhancement: Many students noted that the workshop significantly</p>

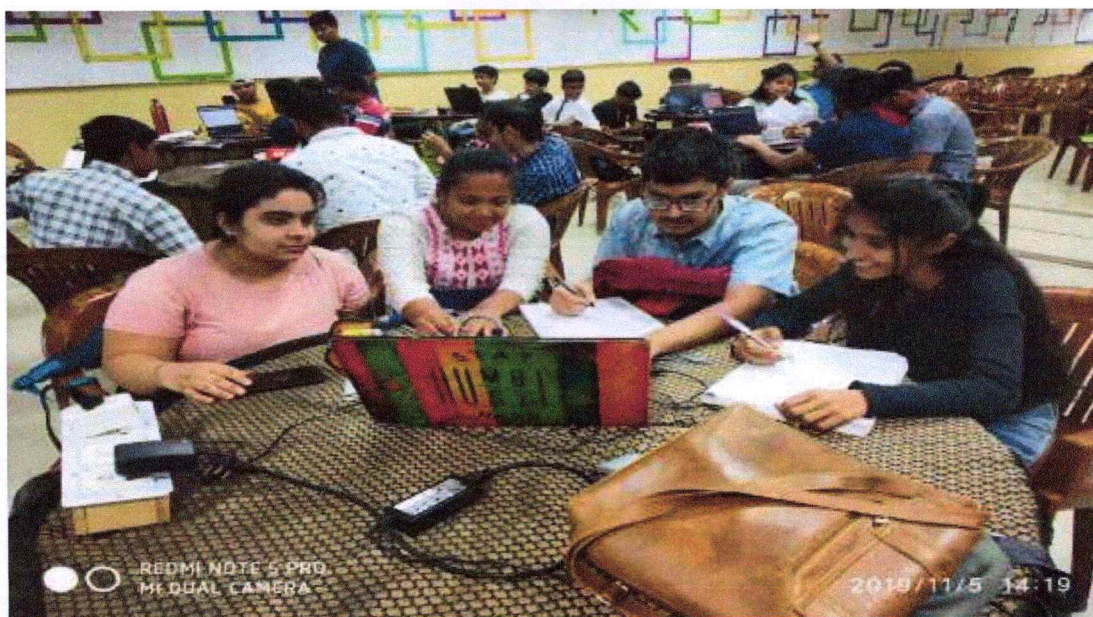

International Computer Driving Licence is been most credentialed online certification program offered to all interdisciplinary to get them computer proficiency in the desired module.
Outcome:	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • The top-ranked Chirag Mathur BCA -III of the first batch (2017-18) who challenged with 10 other Asian countries in the digital challenge that took place in Kuala Lumpur in 2019. He was the only Indian student who participated in the competition. The certification was issued by the Singapore Headquarters for ICDL.
Brief Report:	ICDL (International Computer Driving Licence) was a leading computer skills certification globally, meeting the digital skills needs of students and professionals across Asia. It emphasized an international grading scale for evaluation and was adopted by several Asian governments. Completion led to grading, with top performers competing in the Asia Digital Challenge. The course had three modules (BASE, Professional, Digital), designed for career demands and updated technology. Last year, 38 students, including 27 from BCA, participated, completing modules like Advanced MS-Word and MS-Excel. Top performer Chirag Mathur BCA-III secured 5th position in the 2019 Kuala Lumpur digital challenge. Faculty also enrolled, completing Basic modules. Despite lockdown interruptions, the program offered 21 modules for international proficiency. Chirag Mathur was the only Indian student in the 2019 Kuala Lumpur competition, receiving certification from ICDL's Singapore Headquarters.
Feedback Report:	Most of the students expressed high levels of satisfaction with the ICDL Advance Module on digital awareness. They appreciated the comprehensive coverage of topics and the practical approach to learning. Students found the content highly relevant to their daily lives, both academically and professionally. The module effectively addressed various aspects of digital awareness, including online security, digital ethics, and effective communication in the digital age.
