










National Service Scheme


The NSS unit of St. Xavier's College Jaipur aims at the participation, particularly of undergraduate students on a voluntary basis in various activities of social services.

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III.Co-curricular Activities


St. Xavier's College promotes its students to participate in various clubs like XMS, XDS, XTS & XFS.



Sports and Games


St. Xavier's College Jaipur, encourages its students to participate in various sports and games. The sports faculty helps the students to perform well in sports at university level, State level and National level.

IV. **Student Council**


A student council is a representative body of students elected by their peers to voice their opinions and concerns, plan and organize college activities, and contribute to the overall improvement of the college community.

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V. E-Cell


The IIC Council & E-Cell is responsible for overseeing the activities and initiatives of the innovation and incubation centre and entrepreneurial activities in the institute.
