### 3. Details of the Activities organized/ Work Performed:

Gender study cell is a significant part of an education institute to ensure gender equality and gender sensitization in all approaches. In the session the cell was reinstated with **Dr. Rama Hirawat and Ms Poorvi Medatwal** as teacher coordinators and Soumitra Somendra and Anima Dwivedi as student Coordinators. The primary goal of the cell was to acquaint students with the interdisciplinary academic field devoted to the analysis of Gender and Society. But its scope went beyond the academic constraints where students were involved in intellectually challenging and engaging ways of examining the world. In doing so, the cell organised the following events:

On October 10 2019 the cell organised its inaugural session with an **Open mic title "I identify".** This event was organised in the student lounge where participation of around 60 students was observed. Students from various departments came together and shared their views and experiences.

Commemorating The National Ayurveda Day on 25th October 2019 the cell organised a guest lecture on the Science of Ayurveda. The speaker professor Hetal Dave, Assistant Professor National Institute of Ayurveda, Jaipur shed light on the benefits of adopting Ayurveda in the day to day life specially for women during menstruation.
