International Multidisciplinary Conference on Evolving Ecological Concerns: Transgressions, Transitions and Transformation (Conference and Model Making) Date 24-25 Feb 2023

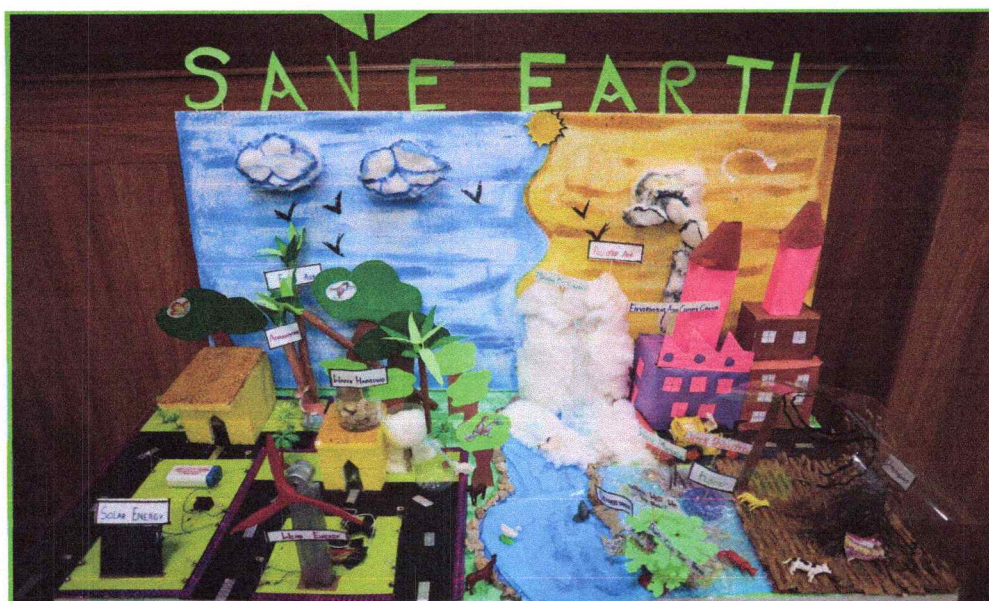
St. Xavier's College organised an international multidisciplinary conference on Evolving Ecological Concerns: Transgressions, Transitions and Transformation on 24th and 25th of February, 2023. Rev Fr Dr S Ignacimuthu SJ (Director, Xavier's Research Foundation, St. Xavier's College, Palayamkottai) and Rev. Fr. Dr K. Job, (Professor, Cosmology, Science & Religion, Jnana Deepa Vidyapeeth, Pune) were the chief guest and guest of honour respectively in the inauguration ceremony. Rev. Fr. S. Maria Packiam SJ (Director, Entomology Research Institute, Loyola College – Chennai) and Rev Fr. Lancelot Dacruz SJ (Associate Professor (Botany), St. Xavier's College, Ahmedabad) were the chief guest and guest of honour respectively in the valedictory ceremony. Seven technical sessions were organised – technical session IV and VII were sub-divided into TS IV A, TS IV B, TS VII A and TS VII B. A panel discussion was organised on the second day of the conference moderated by Rev Fr Dr S Ignacimuthu SJ. Rev Fr. Lancelot Dacruz SJ, Dr D K Saxena (Former Director of Mines Safety, Ministry of Labour & Employment, GOI), Dr B S Nathawat (Environmental Advocate- NGT Bhopal, Rajasthan High Court & Supreme Court of India), and Ms Garima Patet (Director L & D Hub, Taj Group of Hotels) were the panellists.

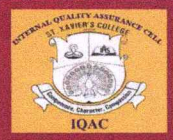
Technical Session I was titled Ecological Business Practices: Emerging Dimensions, it was chaired by Dr Ajay Kumar Pandey and the keynote speaker was Dr Sanober Khan. Technical Session II was titled Emerging Dimensions in the Business and Financial Sector, chaired by Dr Kapil Dev Sharma and the keynote lecture was delivered by Dr Tanushree Sharma. Economic Growth and Ecological Concerns was the name of Technical Session III which was chaired by Prof. Meeta Mathur and Prof. Meeta Keswani Mehra delivered the keynote address. Technical Session IV was titled Literature and Ecology,

It was divided into two separate technical sessions TS IV A and TS IV B. TS IV A was chaired by Dr Preeti Bhatt and Prof. Nidhi Singh delivered the keynote address. TS IV B was chaired by Dr Sonal Sharma. Ecology and Socio-Political Concerns: Conflicts and Resolutions was the title of Technical Session V. It was chaired by Dr Daisy Sharma and keynote address was delivered by Dr Arvind Verma. Technical Session VI was titled Psycho-Ecology: Emerging Discourse of Ecological Influences on Human Behaviour. Chaired by Dr Padmini Jain and Dr Payal Kanwar Chandel delivered the keynote address. Technical Session VII – Science and Technology: Climatic Transgressions and Digital Transformations was divided into sessions; TS VII A and TS VII B. TS VII A was chaired by Dr Mona Sharma and Dr R. Ravindhran delivered the keynote address. Dr Sameer Saxena and Dr Gaurav Agarwal were the chairperson and resource person respectively for TS VII B. All sessions were conducted in hybrid mode.

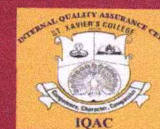


REPORT

The objectives of the workshop were to understand the concepts and challenges of rural sanitation, the policies and guidelines of GOI and state governments on rural sanitation, discussing the Swachhta Action Plan and its implementation aspects and understanding the sanitation technologies. The Chief Guest for the Inaugural was **Sh. Vishwa Mohan Sharma, IAS** (Director, Swachh Bharat Mission-G, Government of Rajasthan) who explained the importance of Swachhata and the work done by the government. The Guest of Honour was Sh.
