

Brief Report:

The International Multi-Disciplinary Conference at St, Xavier's College - Jaipur, is an academically directed effort towards research into specific themes across the various domains of knowledge. This year's theme "Evolving Ecological Concerns: Transgressions, Transitions and Transformation "had been conceived to explore different views, insights, discoveries, innovations related to the ecological issues and concerns, from scholars, researchers, and professionals. The aim was to provide a unique platform to raise awareness about upcoming innovations in multi-disciplinary approaches towards learning.

The first day began with a very enriching Inaugural Ceremony, which was graced by the benign presence of Rev Fathers, the Chief Guest Rev. Fr. Dr S. Ignacimuthu, SJ, - Director, Xavier's Research Foundation, St. Xavier's College, Palayamkottai, Guest of Honour Rev. Fr. Dr K. Job, Professor, Cosmology, Science & Religion, Jnana Deepa Vidyapeeth, Pune.

The first session, Ecological Transformation in Business Practices: Emerging Dimensions was chaired by Dr Ajay Kumar Pandey Associate Professor, Faculty of Management Studies & Behavioural Sciences, Amity University, Haryana. 
