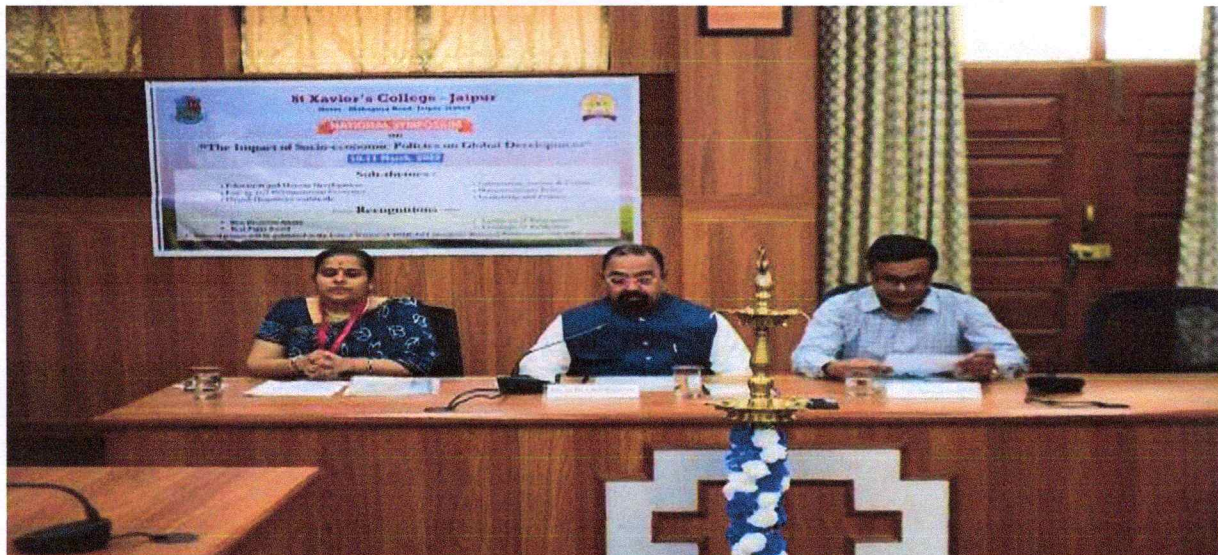

NATIONAL SYMPOSIUM

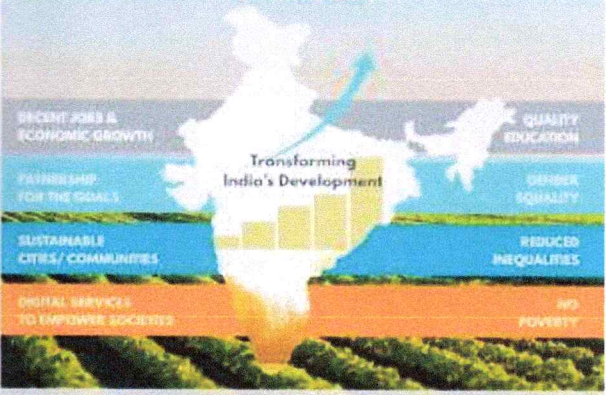

GUIDELINES FOR THE PAPER

- The following submission guidelines are to be adhered to:
- Abstract should not exceed 300 words and shall be accompanied by 4-5 key words.
 - All papers shall be submitted in English.
 - Co-authorship is permitted, subject to a list of Authors per submission.
 - Cover page containing the Author's Name, University Organization, Paper Title, Email Address and Mobile Number shall be attached with the submission email, and the said details shall also be mentioned in the body of the email.
 - All research papers must represent original ideas and representations compiled with critical evaluation and assessment.
 - Word Limit: 4000-6000 words (inclusive of references).
 - No part of the paper shall have been published earlier or should be under consideration for publication. Any form of plagiarism shall result in immediate disqualification.
 - Selected papers for presentation and participants of the symposium shall be asked to SE in a registration form after the commencement of activities, or register in person at the symposium.
 - In case of co-authorship, at least one person must attend the symposium to make the presentation.
 - For more information, participants should contact researchproject@stxaviercollegejaipur.org under the subject title "Entry for National Symposium - National Symposium" in Microsoft Word doc or docx format.
 - The title page shall contain the full name of the authors.
