Impact lecture Series on 3 May 2024 Speaker 1: Dr. Abhishek Pareek CEO, Atal Incubation Center, Banasthali University Topic: "From Conceptualization to Enterprise: Navigating the Path from Ideation to Startup Success". Speaker 2: Mr. Yash Garg Founder, Silver Tree Topic: "From Theory to Practice: Sharing My Entrepreneurial Story" The impact lecture sessions in selected IIC institutions will not only a streamlined campus innovation and start-up ecosystem but also help in







establishing strong connection with ecosystem enablers at regional and national level, and aware students and faculty members about innovation ecosystem in their surrounding and at national level.

- 2. Institution Innovation Council is organized a session on "Entrepreneurial Elevation: Igniting Youthful Ambitions" on National Youth Day by Mr. Vaibhav Pandey on 12th January, 2024. Mr. Vaibhav Pande is an entrepreneur, a TEDX speaker, Josh Talks speaker, top 10 inspiring personalities list by India Today magazine and listed in Fortune Magazine. The session was organized to enrich students in regard to the entrepreneurial journey.
- 3. The Intellectual Property Rights (IPR) Cell and Institutions Innovative Council (IIC) Cell of St. Xavier's College Jaipur organized Online Joint Workshop on IPR Patents, Designs in association with RGNIIPM Nagpur. Pre-registration is mandatory to participate in the program. The resource person for the session was Dr. Bharat N Suryawanshi is working for more than 20 years in Central Government Office under the Patent Office, Ministry of Commerce and; Industry and presently worked as Assistant Controller of Patents and; Designs. The workshop was conducted to promote awareness about patents and its procedure to apply.
- 4. Telecast of PM address on the vision for Viksit Bharat@2047, which was unveiled by the honourable prime minister on December 11, 2023, at 10:30 am, was presented before the teachers and students at St. Xavier's College Jaipur in the conference room. By launching this programme, the Indian government is reinstating its aim to make the country a developed nation by 2047, when the country will celebrate its centennial of independence. The vision seeks to construct an India that thrives by embracing several aspects of progress, including economic growth, social development, environmental sustainability, and good governance. The Prime Minister called on the youth of India to take part and use their enthusiasm, determination, energy, talent, and capacity to help India achieve Viksit Bharat by the year 2047. To spread the principles and mission of Viksit Bharat to every young person in the country, he urged educational institutions, students, and teachers to launch outreach programmes. A large number of students, teachers, and staff members showed up to the event. With the whole faculty and student body in attendance, Principal Fr. Prof. S. Xavier, SJ, gave the concluding comments.
- 5. National symposium and Knowledge Transfer Programme (College to Village Village to College), an Entrepreneurship Training Initiative and the 3rd National Symposium from 2-4 March 2024 on the theme 'Envisaging Viksit Bharat @ 2047'. An eminent resource person Prof Krishnendu Acharya, University of Calcutta, interacted with the students and shared a wealth of experience and knowledge. In an engaging ideathon led by Professor Krishnendu, students created 22 business concepts, out of which the top three were recognized with awards Spanning







three days, the programme includes sessions on entrepreneurship and organic farming, and it encouraged student research through paper presentations.

- **6. UDHGAM National entrepreneurship Drive (NED) IIT GUWAHATI**: A team of 4 students was selected among top 10 teams from all over India to participate the final pitching battle which was held on 21st January, 2024 for an entrepreneurial event organized by E cell of IIT Guwahati. The college borne the expenses for travel and accommodation of the selected students to promote such participations in the future.
- **7. Mentor mentee scheme**: The college had applied for the mentor- mentee scheme of IIC MoE Innovation Cell in response to the application the Directorate of Entrepreneurship cell, Manipal University Jaipur was selected as our mentor for IIC 6.0 (academic year 2023-24). The scheme was joined with withstand towards striving to develop and enhance innovation and entrepreneurial ecosystem for the development of the economy.
- **8. Regional meet (MIC driven Activity):** two students and two faculties represented the College at Regional meet organised by the AICTE and hosted by Amity University Jaipur. The college also participated in the poster making competition and showcased the activities and achievements of IIC in the institution.


