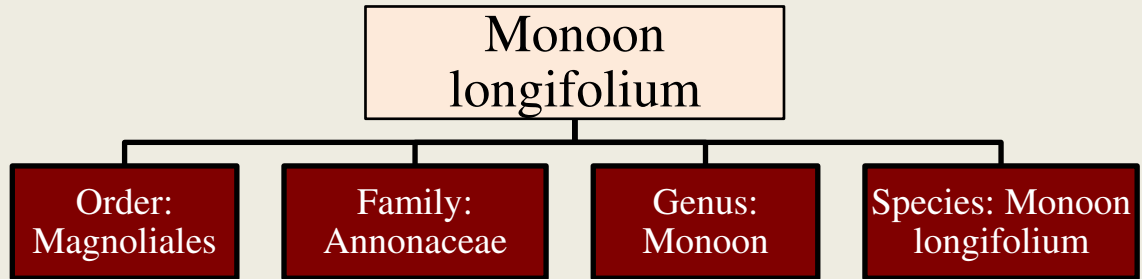


Common Name: Ashoka Pendula



DESCRIPTION

- It is native to southern India and Sri Lanka. Tree grows over 20 m. in height.
- In spring, the tree is covered with delicate star-like pale green flowers.
- The leaves are used for ornamental decoration during festivals and oil of the seed has been used to possess anti-oxidant, anti-lipooxygenase and antimicrobial infection.
