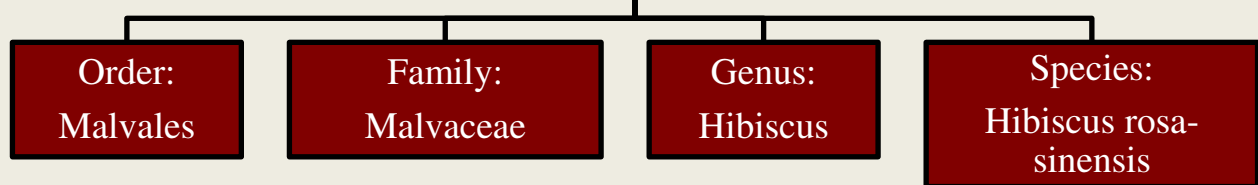


Gudhal

Hibiscus rosa-sinensis



DESCRIPTION

- The hibiscus is an evergreen shrub, growing to a maximum of 10 m in the wild. Its bark is light-grey, easy to peel and smooth.
- Plant is cultivated in tropic and subtropic as ornamental purpose but it is native to Vanuatu.
- The flowers used in salads, shining shoes, and as a pH indicator.
- The plant is considered to have a number of medical uses in Chinese herbology.
