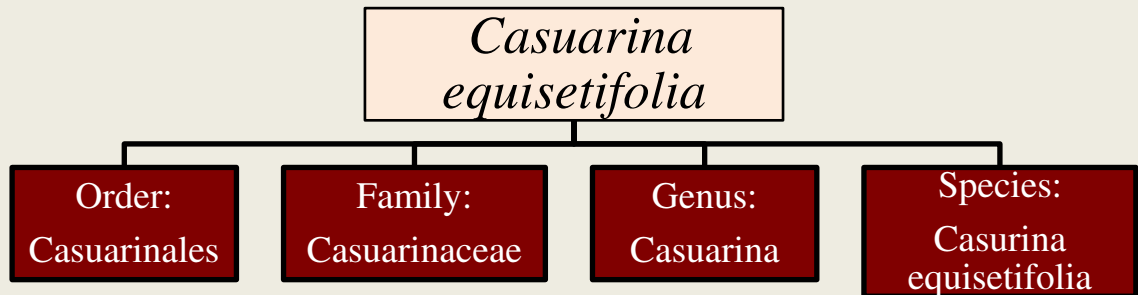


# Horse tail



## DESCRIPTION

- It is a monoecious tree that typically grows to a height of 6–12 m (20–39 ft) with scaly or furrowed bark on older specimens
- It is native to Australia, New Guinea, Southeast Asia and India.
- Casuarina is widely planted for coastal reclamation, erosion control, tannin, pulp, timber. Other than ornamental purposes, Casuarina has potential in remediation of textile dye wastewater.
