

3. Objective:

- foster quality culture in the institutional functioning
- develop standard operating procedure and policies for various units of college
- To sustain the initiatives taken by various units of the college for overall development of the institution
- To coordinate and work as a bridge between different units of the college

4. Details of the Activities organized/ Work Performed:

The IQAC had carried forward its work related to quality initiatives and preparation for NAAC accreditation which was started in the academic session 2018-19. This year due to the shifting and merger of the college and ongoing pandemic the IQAC's role became more





important to further the cause of quality education on account of continuation of online teaching and addition of new staff members. Following initiatives were taken during the academic session 2021-22:

- a. The draft Policies and Guidelines prepared last year according to NAAC requirement for all the cells/clubs/committees of the college with the help of teaching staff members and Steering Committee was reviewed again this year to factor in the merger and pandemic impact. All the finalized drafts have been sent to college management for final approval which will be eventually translated into a college manual.
- b. IQAC is a link between UGC and college units for the implementation of Quality Mandate given by UGC. An 11-point program was prepared by the UGC for improving the quality of education in HEIs. Efforts were made to implement some of these in the session with the help of college units. For this purpose, the Academic Planning was initiated by IQAC by collecting the event proposals in a structured manner from all the units of college for the session 2021-22. This was converted into Academic Planner of the college in consultation with all the departments and major units of college.
- c. Covid-19 Awareness Webinar Series was organized in June 2021 by the Covid Action Committee under the aegis of IQAC to create awareness about impact of second wave of covid-19, preparation for the third wave, and myths & facts about covid vaccines for the staff, students, parents, and general public. The resource persons were Dr. Rajat Bhargava, Asso Prof, Department of Gastroenterology, Mahatma Gandhi Hospital and University, Dr. Raghav Shah, Department of Psychiatry, Rajasthan Hospital, Jaipur, Dr. Hema Singh, Department of Endocrinology, Metro Mass Hospital, Jaipur, and Dr. Nishtha Singh, Asthama Bhawan, Jaipur.
- d. Streamlining and effective implementation of ERP for all the units of the college. In this direction a week-long ERP Training Workshop was organized from 21-26 June 2021 by ERP committee under the aegis of IQAC for teaching and non-teaching staff to gain complete know-how about the system.
- e. Ten-day NAAC Induction Workshop on NAAC Assessment and Preparedness was organized from 7th to 17th July 2021, for both teaching and non-teaching staff. The aim was to gain complete knowledge about all the seven criterions of assessment and accreditation of Higher Educational Institutions, to derive an

understanding of the 'Quality Status' of the Institution and to prepare for the first cycle of NAAC Accreditation. The resource persons were Prof. Joseph Dorairaj, Gandhigram Institute, TN, Dr. Prashant Borkar, MasterSoft, and all the Steering Committee members of St. Xavier's College, Jaipur.

- f. Feedback on teaching-learning (Annual Academic Feedback for the teaching staff) and Peer Feedback with the help of ERP for all staff was conducted in December 2021 and February 2022 respectively. The report on the same along with feedback result was submitted to the college management.
- g. NIRF 2021 data was collected and submitted for the ranking process with the help of university affairs cell and college office.
- h. A two-day workshop on NAAC module (ADMS) was organized in 4-5 April 2022 with the help of ERP committee to train the steering committee members for the data collection and segregation of last seven-year data. It will be managed by the Steering Committee based on their criteria management for the preparation of Self Study Report.
- ii. Academic and Administrative Audit (AAA) was organized on 29-30 April 2022 for all the units of college to assess our preparedness for NAAC accreditation with the help of external auditors Prof. Joseph Dorairaj, Gandhigram Institute, TN and Dr. Marry Magdalene, Fatima College, TN. The departments were supposed to collect the data for the last seven years and present the same to the auditors through the Department Questionnaire for NAAC. It also includes necessary documentation and filling as proof for the data collected. A session was conducted for office staff to assess their preparedness for NAAC and review meeting with IQAC and Steering Committee was organized to discuss about the issues and challenges for the NAAC preparation. The auditors submitted their report (SWOC Analysis) to college management for improving and strengthening the working of college.
- j. The Government of Rajasthan has initiated Annual Audit Program (AAP) for private colleges from session 2021-22. This is based on the NAAC criteria and an institutional grading is calculated criteria wise depending upon the data submitted in the required format. IQAC has submitted the format to the college education department and consequently its report was submitted to the college management.

- k. IQAC has prepared an Action Plan for the College and its various units based on the recommendations of the external auditors, suggestions from departments and steering committee, and the AAP result. The criteria wise Action Plan keeping in mind the NAAC accreditation is submitted to the college management for necessary approval and implementation from the next session.
- Documentation Centre collected the event information data in a structured manner throughout the year from different units of the college for session 2021-22.
- m. Performance Based Appraisal System (PBAS) has been developed by IQAC based on the API format of UGC. It will be circulated amongst all teaching staff members for self-evaluation for the session 2021-22.
