


# Principal's Message Prof. (Fr.) S. Xavier SJ

#### MoU with Jeevandan Charitable Society (NAVCHETAN)



#### **ACTIVITIES IN MARCH 2024**

#### 3rd National Symposium on Envisaging Viksit Bharat @ 2047



The Research and Development Cell of St. Xavier's College Jaipur inaugurated the 'National Symposium – Knowledge Transfer Programme 'College to Village & Village to College' & Entrepreneurship Training Initiative' on the theme - "Envisaging Viksit Bharat@2047."

The 3-day National Symposium – Knowledge Transfer Programme & Entrepreneurship Training Initiative commenced on 1 March 2024, held in the college auditorium. Dr. Kailash Verma, the MLA from Bagru Constituency, was the Chief Guest at the inauguration who appreciated the significant changes in the educational environment that St. Xavier's College Jaipur has introduced in Nevta.

Professor Krishnendu Acharya, Head – Department of Botany, University of Calcutta was the distinguished speaker, interacting with the college's students, faculty members and farmers from the 5 villages adopted under UBA by the college for three days, 1-3 March 2024. In an engaging 'Ideathon' led by Professor Acharya, students created 22 business concepts, out of which the top three were recognised with awards in the closing ceremony. The concept behind Ideathon was to give a hands-on entrepreneurship training to the students.

On 2 March 2024, day 2 of the symposium, under the Knowledge Transfer Programme (College to Village, Village to College), the students, faculty members and Prof. Acharya visited the farmers of the 5 villages adopted under UBA to share practically applicable knowledge to encourage farmer towards organic farming that is economically viable and profitable – knowledge from



lab to land was enthusiastically shared. The college reached out to the villages and on 3 March 2024, the farmers came to college to carry forward the previous day's learning in the college campus.

Moreover, on 3 March 2024 the students of the college made presentations on their research projects done under the mentorship of their professors in seven different technical sessions. The heads of the respective departments chaired the sessions and gave valuable insights to researchers to improve their research work. The day ended with an interaction session between Prof. Acharya and faculty members after the valedictory programme.

#### **ACTIVITIES IN MARCH 2024**

#### Lab to Land: Knowledge Transfer Program

Knowledge Transfer Programme -Visit to fields of Khatwara Village villages adopted under the Unnat Bharat Abhiyan Cell on 3 March 2024, as part of the Lab to Land: Bridging the Gap initiative of our college. Prof Krishnendu Acharya from the Dept. of Botony, University of Calcutta, engaged in discussions and interaction with farmers and showcased multiple experiments in their fields. He raised awareness among the farmers about the methods and advantages of organic farming. The main objective of this visit was to conscientise the farmers and emphasise the importance of transitioning to organic farming practices, highlighting its positive impact on environmental sustainability and agricultural productivity.



#### Collaboration Initiative Session with Loyola University, USA by Fr. Michael Engh, SJ



On 5 March 2024, St. Xavier's College Jaipur hosted a Collaboration Initiative Session with Loyola Marymount University, USA. The aim was to explore opportunities for academic partnership for mutual growth. Fr. Dr. Michael Engh, SJ., Chancellor of LMU, emphasised AI's role in education and encouraged faculty to integrate AI tools to enhance learning. The interactive session fostered dialogue and laid the groundwork for a robust academic collaboration, fostering enthusiasm and commitment for future endeavours.

The certificate course on Event Management certification course, spanning approximately 30 hours, commenced on 3 January 2024, with sessions covering diverse topics and led by industry experts like Mr. Gunjan Singhal, Mr. Siddhartha Chaturvedi, Mr. Mahavir Sharma, Ms. Monica Balli and Mr. Rajiv Kapoor. The culmination of the course was the "Pushkar Wedding Event" an exceptional hands-on experience. Six selected students participated from 7 February to 11 February 2024, engaging in various roles such as production, hospitality, and coordination, with accommodation and transportation managed by the wedding planner.

He emphasised reforming existing processes for economic growth, considering India's status as the fastest-growing economy. The panel discussion, "Envisaging Viksit Bharat @ 2047 Scientific & Technological, Environmental & Developmental Perspectives" chaired by Shri Sanyal, explored decentralisation and technology's role in development, with inputs from eminent figures like Prof. E. #### **College Managing Committee Meeting**


