- Annual Training Camp, organised by 3 Raj Naval Unit NCC, is a platform where cadets get chance to learn various aspects of NCC such as drill, weapon training, subjects related to Naval NCC such as Seamanship, Semaphore etc.
- The camp also serves as a medium to provide the cadets with the opportunities to compete with other cadets in several competitions such as Drill Competition, Weapon Stripping And Assembling Competition, Sports Competition, Cultural Competition. Such activities allow the cadets to cater sportsmenship, competitive behavior with a zeal of unity amongst them.
- The cadets followed a specified daily routine right from 5 a.m. in the morning till 10 p.m. at night. The common activities held everyday were muster calls, morning PT, drill, theoretical classes and evening sports activities.
- Several special classes were also organised such as fire fighting class, self defense class, ship modeling class, a special interactive session on SSB selections.
- The Sports competitions included, relay race, tug of war, volleyball match and physical education test. The cultural competitions included musical and dancing competitions.

- The other competitions comprised of, PPT competition, debate competition, rifle stripping and assembling competition, drill competition, quiz competition.
- Most of the cadets from St Xavier's College bought laurels to the unit as well as to the institute in various kinds competitions.

































SAILING EXPEDITION CAMP 19 TO 28 JUNE 2024

- The expedition camp aims at making the cadets articulate about boat navigation powered by wind energy, nurture self-confidence, foster teamwork and instill survival capabilities near the water. The camp seeks to kindle cadets' interest in watermanship activities
- The camp was organised at 2 Raj Naval Unit NCC, Ajmer.
- The daily routine for the camp included regular boat pulling for 500-600 meters at Ana Sagar, followed by theoretical classes on seamanship, rigging, semaphore etc.
- For once, the cadets went for boat pulling and they covered the whole Ana Sagar in one round, which in itself is an achievement for the cadets who performed boat pulling for the first time.
- Eight cadets from St. Xavier's College Jaipur got selected and went ahead for the camp. These cadets represented 3 Raj Naval Unit NCC.
- The cadets gained victory in various competitions such as Boat Pulling, Drill Competition, Sailing Competition, Rigging Competition, Service Subject Test. In competitions such as Semaphore and Swimming, two of our Senior Division cadets, Cdt. Mohit Singh Rathore, L.Cdt. Kush Shekhawat, and one of the Senior Wing cadets, L.Cdt. Molly Bhargava won individual medals.

The cadets got an opportunity to perceive extensive knowledge for the same and gained a whole new experience of a camp poles apart from ATC camp that the cadets had previously attended.
