DESCRIPTION

- They grow along seacoasts and in marshy places and forests of tropical and subtropical regions, especially in Asia, Africa, and Oceania.
- Pandanus will typically reach about 4 to 14 metres tall and 3 to 8 metres wide depending on which species you establish. The growth rate is considered slow to moderate in most conditions.
- Much use is made of the leaves for thatching, mats, hats, ropes, twine, sails for small boats, baskets, and fibre products
- The fleshy fruits and seeds of some species, are edible.
