Faculty Development Programs - 2023-24

Workshops on National Education Policy 2020 (26 June - 13 July 2023)

The National Education Policy 2020 (NEP 2020) aims to transform India's education system by promoting holistic, multidisciplinary, and inclusive approaches. With a focus on flexibility, the policy seeks to align education with global standards while preserving Indian values.

The inaugural Workshop on National Education Policy 2020 featured *Prof. B. Thimme Gowda*, former Vice Chairman of the Karnataka State Higher Education

Council, as the resource person. He provided insights into NEP's origins, objectives, and its scope for transforming education. A second workshop for the Science, Social Science, and Humanities departments was led by *Prof. Fr.*

Dejus J. R. from St. Xavier's College, Kolkata, who helped align the curriculum with NEP 2020.

On June 30, 2023, a workshop for the School of Business, with *Prof. Sougata Banerjee* of St. Xavier's College, Kolkata, explored NEP's implications for commerce and business education. Another event on web design and social media strategies on June 28 was led by *Prof. Fr. Dejus J. R.*, highlighting the importance of digital tools in academia. *Dr. Paul Newman*, Principal of St. Joseph's Evening College, Bengaluru, delved into the unique characteristics of Jesuit education and NEP in a session on July 4, 2023.



On July 13, 2023, IQAC at St. Xavier's College, Jaipur, hosted a session with *Prof. G. P. Singh* from the University of Rajasthan, focusing on NEP implementation in affiliated colleges and aligning curriculum and pedagogy with policy guidelines.

ERP Workshop on NEP Module (10-12 July 2023)

Three-Day Workshop on Research and Publication for Academicians (4-6 September 2023)



The session concluded with a discussion on avoiding certain mistakes while writing a literature review.

Indexing Parameters and Manuscript Preparation: Writing for Impact was the focal point of the second day. Fr Joseph Varghese elaborated upon research

The session of the third day was titled **Choosing the Right Journal** and began with a detailed exposition of indexing parameters like Impact Factor, Cite Score, h-index, and i10-index. He also elaborated on how to navigate open-access options and how to spot predatory journals.

The second day of the FDP started on a solemn note with a prayer by Dr Sr Ligimol Louis. The second day session was taken by Dr Michael Rajamathi R, Dr J Nelapaty Endowment Chair, St. Joseph's University, Bengaluru. Dr Rajamathi began the session by discussing that the purpose of education is to develop intra and inter-personal skills of the students and how the focus should be on improving mind functions. To this end, he added it is imperative for us as teachers to be familiar with Bloom's Taxonomy. The session focused on the cognitive domain and the

hierarchy of learning- Knowledge, Understanding, Application, Analysis, Synthesis, and Evaluation (KUPASE). The participants were then asked to sit department-wise and prepare Learning Outcomes for core papers of the NEP batch (Semester I and II), these were then discussed in the presence of the resource person who gave valuable insights into the outcomes made.



The fourth-day session by *Rev. Fr. Francis P Xavier SJ* commenced with an insightful discussion on the characteristics of Jesuit education. Fr. Xavier highlighted the Pareto Principle (80/20 Rule), illustrating how a small percentage of causes often lead to a large percentage of effects. In education and socio-economic contexts, this can be seen in resource allocation and outcomes. The influence of Artificial Intelligence (AI) on education was a key point of discussion.

The highlight of the fifth day was an enlightening session by Fr Francis P. Xavier, Program Director at the Doctor Ambedkar Cultural Academy (DACA) in Madurai. With his extensive expertise and deep scholarship, Father Xavier provided a comprehensive exploration of International



Collaboration and Time, Mind, and Schedule Management. He elaborated on the necessity of international collaborations,

illustrated through the integration of PQ (Physical Quotient), IQ (Intellectual Quotient), EQ (Emotional Quotient), SQ (Spiritual Quotient), JQ (Jesuit Quotient), and EcoQ (Ecological Quotient).

IQAC Annual Meeting (29 June 2024)






