Various initiatives have been taken to empower students and faculty with the knowledge of AI tools, resulting in the formation of an AI team as a key milestone in building competency in AI tools across the North Zone Jesuit colleges and institutions.

Formation of the AI Team

Faculty Development Programs (FDPs) on AI Tools





Session on Artificial Intelligence and its Applications in Higher Education

Earlier a two-day workshop on Indian Knowledge System was organized on 16-17 June 2024, under the aegis of the Faculty Development Training and Exchange Program Cell (FDTEPC) and the Internal Quality Assurance Cell (IQAC). This workshop included a special session on "Artificial Intelligence and its Applications in Higher Education" by Fr. Olvin Veigas, SJ, Assistant

Professor at St. Joseph's Institute of Management (SJIM), Bengaluru. This session offered hands-on experience to the faculty members with various AI tools like autodraw.com, remove.bg, and Canva Magic, blending traditional knowledge with modern AI applications. He highlighted AI's potential to enhance personal productivity, personalize teaching content, and catalyze faculty teaching technologies, while also cautioning against the negative impacts on students, such as increased distraction and over-reliance on technology.





Departmental Initiatives and Guest Lectures

The Department of Economics organized a lecture series titled "Aspects of Responsible AI to Shape the Economy" on 12 September

2024. Dr. Avik Sarkar from the Indian School of Business, Mohali, provided insights into the ethical dimensions and economic impact of AI, illustrating its potential in fostering innovation and job creation. He stressed the need for further research in AI, as India currently trails behind Western countries, and called for integrating AI into the education system. The session covered AI's impact on innovation, job creation, and ethical considerations, highlighting AI's economic potential and the importance of responsible usage.




National Nutrition Week Celebration - Awareness Drive (2-6 September 2024)

cultural committee, brought together staff and students in a joyful and festive atmosphere.




