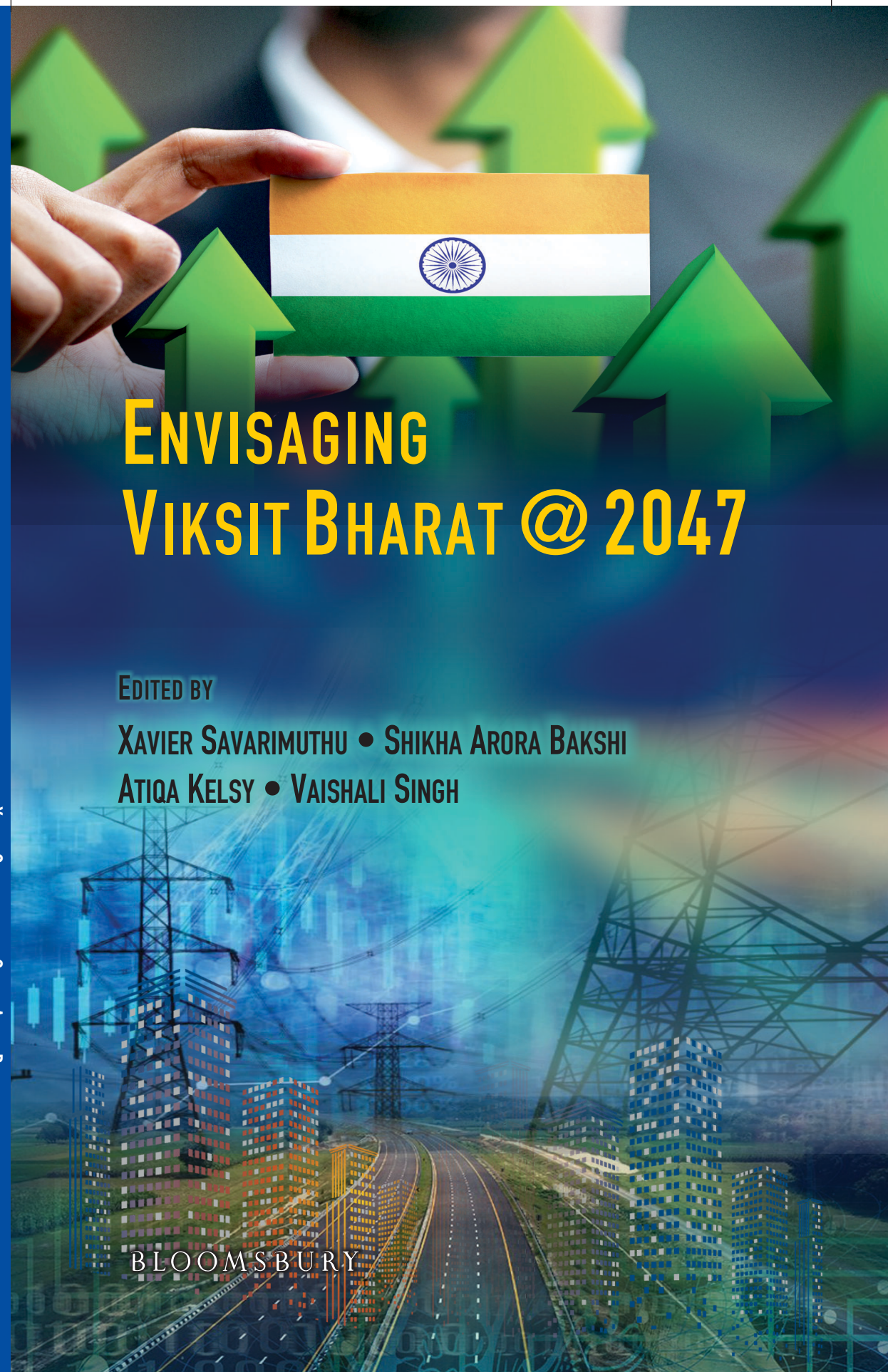
The book is an attempt to address the above-mentioned issues and encourage different perspectives to converge into a single vision of a developed India and how we can achieve it by 2047.
