The full version of your paper should be formatted as per the guidelines given below.

Paper Format

- Abstract: 250 words (maximum) with 5-7 Keywords.
- Full paper: 5000-8000 words (including the text, figures, tables, references and appendices)
- Document type: Microsoft Word
- Title page: Title and names of all the authors with complete affiliation
- Font: Times New Roman, 12 point (main text), 14 point (heading), 16 point (title of the paper)
- Line Spacing: 1.5
- All tables, figures, and graphs included in the text must include their source, have appropriate captions and properly numbered.
- References: APA, 7th edition

Note: The author has to submit the plagiarism report along with the final submission. (similarity < 15%, AI < 10%)
