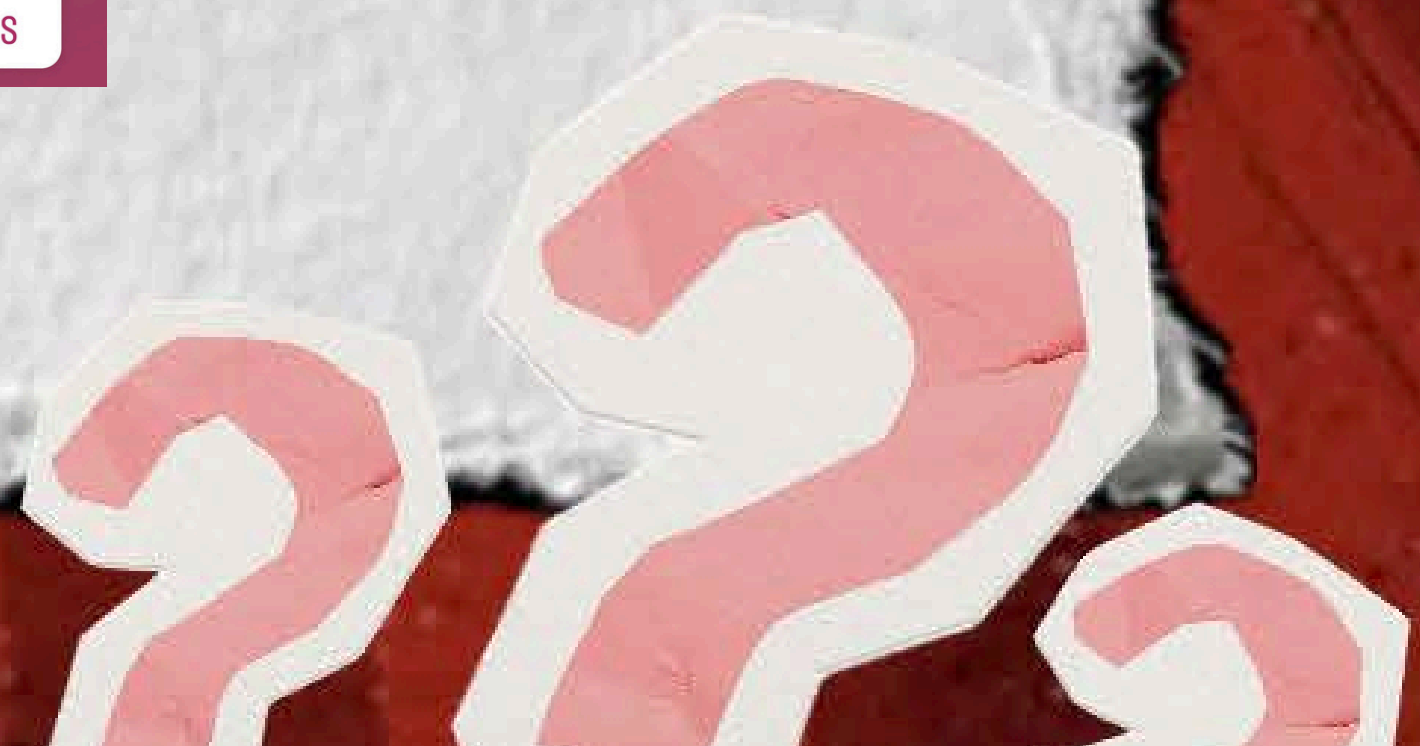

RULES & GUIDELINES

1. Participants may take part individually or in teams (UG: up to 3 members; School: up to 4 members).
2. All models must be based on the theme **“Sustainable Technologies for a Developed India.”**
3. Participants may present working, innovative, or simple models depending on their level.
4. Models should focus on areas such as renewable energy, waste management, water conservation, or eco-friendly solutions.
5. Each team must clearly explain the concept, working and relevance of the model to sustainability.
6. Presentation time will be 5 minutes for college students & 2 minutes for school students.
7. Models must be safe, non-hazardous, and should not involve fire or harmful materials.
8. Use of eco-friendly or recyclable materials is encouraged.
9. UG students must submit a brief report (1-2 pages) describing their model.
10. Evaluation will be based on creativity, understanding, innovation, practical application and presentation skills.
