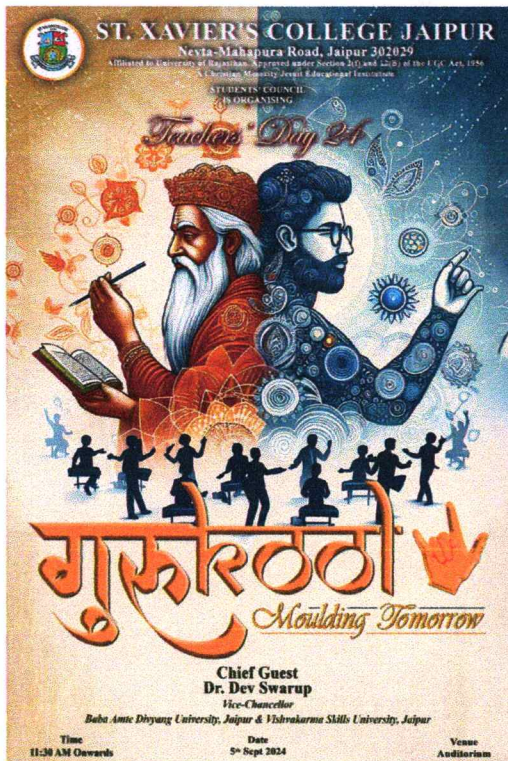

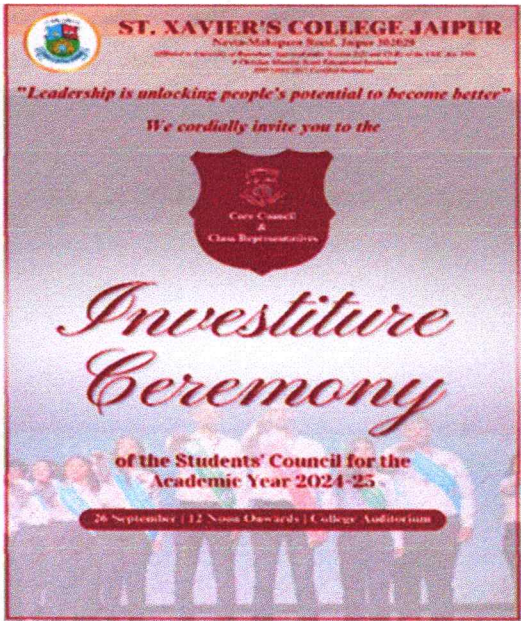

Venue: North Quadrangle , St. Xavier’s College Jaipur

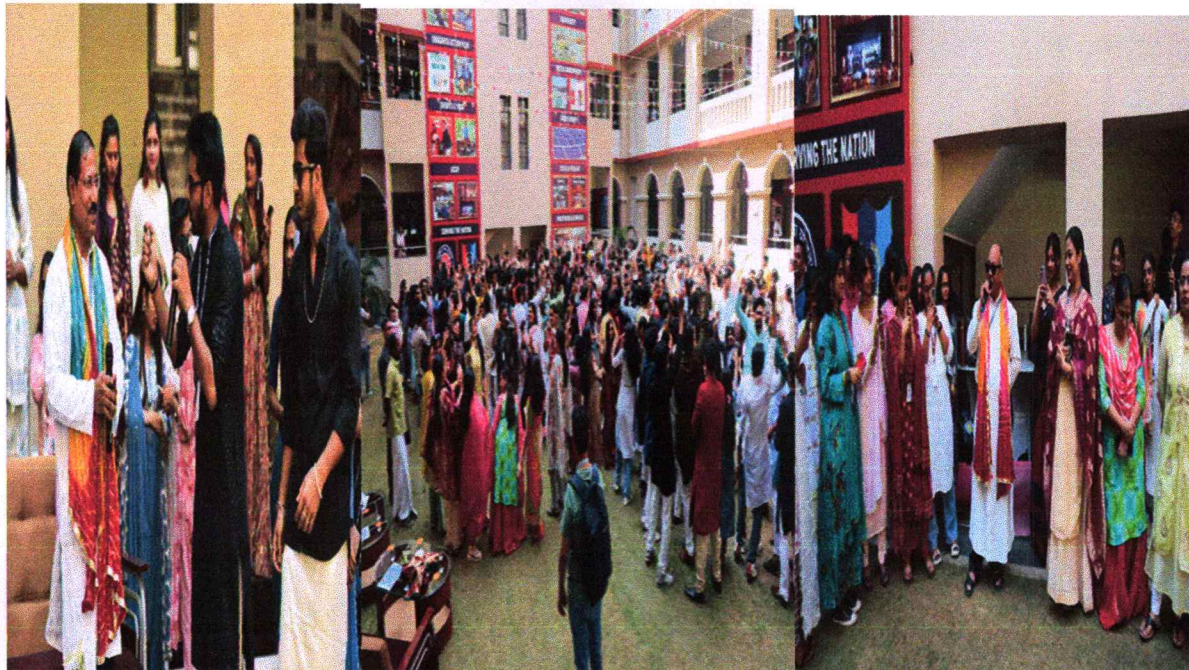

- Considering the large crowd, more sound amplification and audio coordination could improve the overall experience.

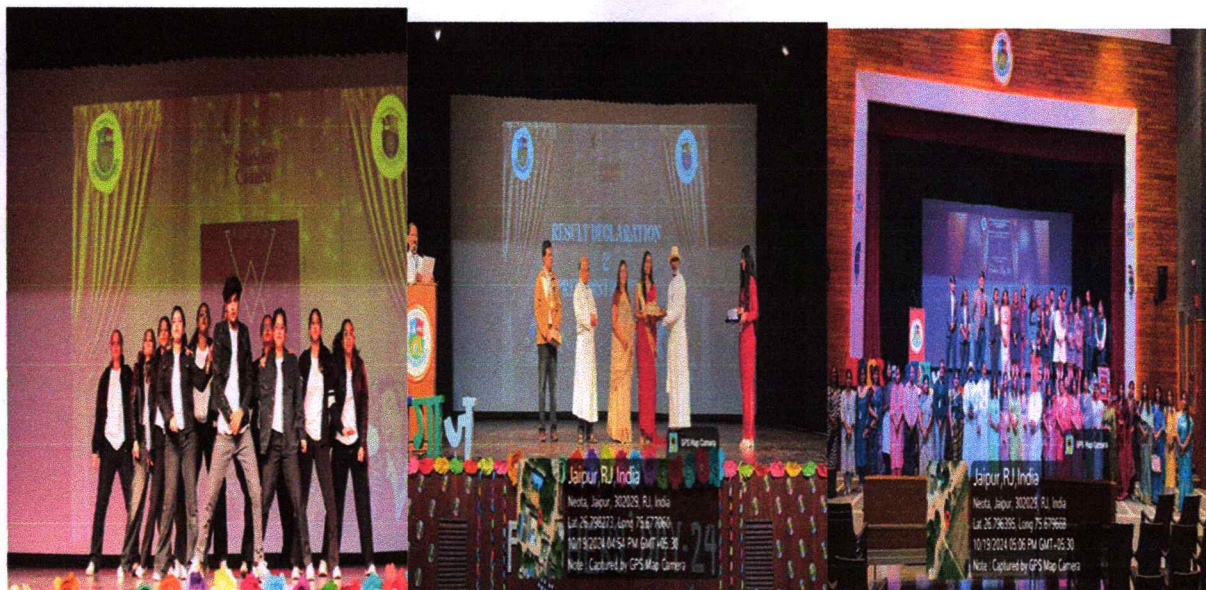
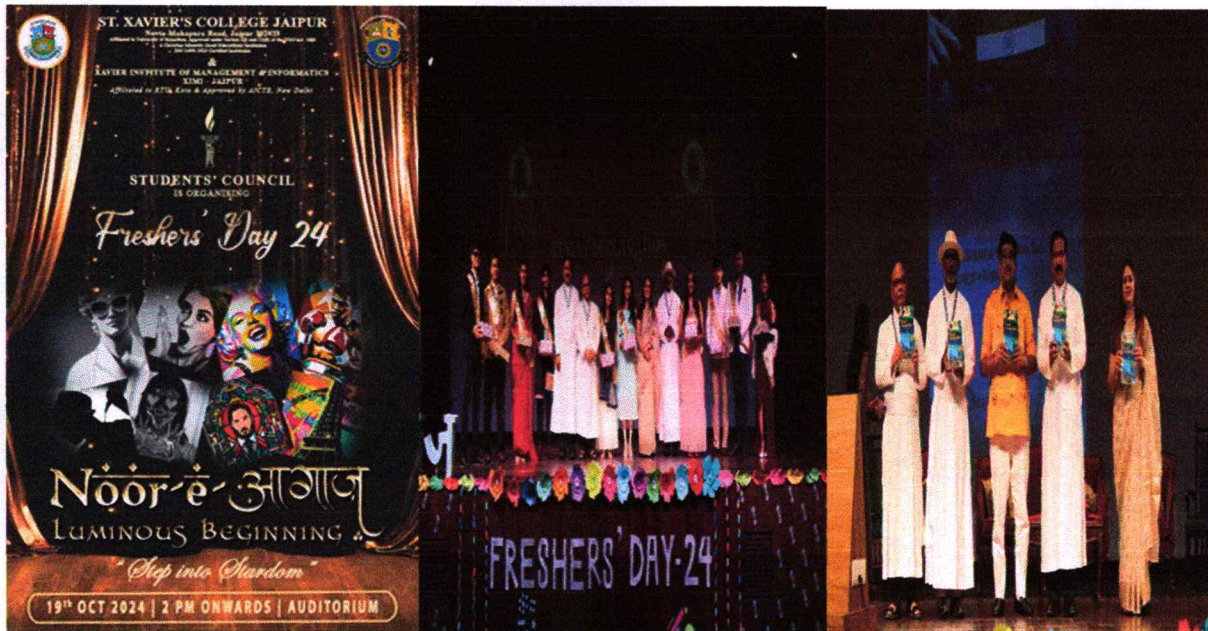
Learning Outcome:

- Introduction of interactive sessions or workshops (pre or post main event) could enhance engagement beyond performances.

- Sign formal memorandums with vendors very carefully in advance to ensure clarity on deliverables, timelines, and payment terms, helping avoid last-minute disputes or delays.
- Secure a written confirmation from artists regarding their arrival and exit timings in advance to ensure smooth time management and avoid last-minute coordination issues.
- Ensure live streaming of marquee events to increase accessibility for students unable to attend physically
- Consider introducing inter-college collaboration events for greater networking and learning exchange

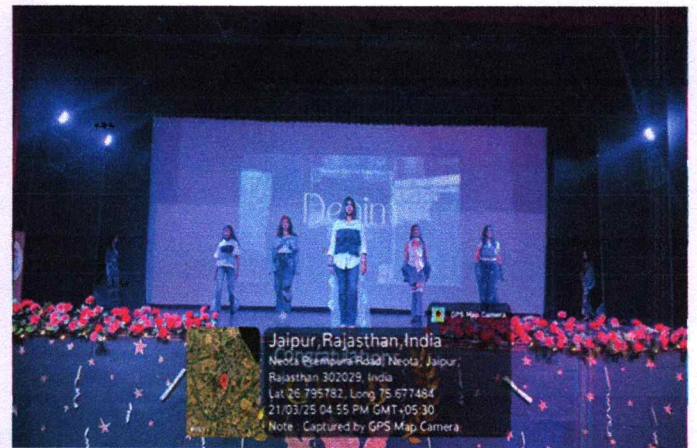

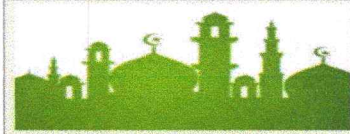
