Event Report	<p>According to Letter No. 2024-25/1625 dated August 23, 2024 Rajasthan State AIDS Control Society has informed all the Red Ribbon clubs of colleges to organize a 5 km marathon. The top three winners of the marathon will further compete at the State Level competition in September 2024. The state-level winner will represent Rajasthan state in the national-level competition in October 2024. The national marathon will be 10 km, and winners will receive a cash prize of up to Rs. 50,000.</p> <p>The Red Ribbon Club at St. Xavier's College, Jaipur, organized the awareness marathon on August 31, 2024 at 8:50 am. The objective of this marathon was to spread awareness about HIV/AIDS among youth. The marathon started with a brief message from Fr Dr Raymond Cherubin SJ, Vice Principal, St. Xavier's College Jaipur, regarding awareness among youth regarding AIDS. Student volunteers prepared different posters to spread awareness of AIDS among the students.</p> <p>College Vice Principal Fr Dr Raymond Cherubin SJ motivated the students and started the marathon with a green signal. In total, 23 students participated in the marathon, and 100 students from the college were present to witness the marathon. Red Ribbon Club Coordinator Dr. Sunita Choudhary, Member of RRC Dr. Mamta Pareek, and Dr. Ajay Dandotiya Sports coach marked their presence to motivate the students.</p> <p>Students enthusiastically participated in the marathon, and the names of the top three students were sent to RSACS for the state-level competition. 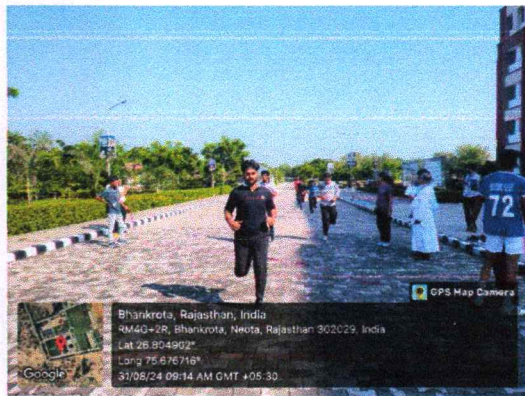

Event Report	<p>The Red Ribbon Club of St. Xavier's College Jaipur, in collaboration with ISREAC/UBA Cell, the National Service Scheme (NSS), Nav Jeevan Kendra, and Search Foundation, organized a Blood Donation Camp on campus in observance of National Voluntary Blood Donation Day on October 1, 2024. The camp took place in Rooms 40 and 41, running from 9:00 AM until the afternoon. The camp commenced with a short awareness session conducted by Dr. Mahavir Saini, a doctor from J.K. Lon Hospital, who explained the importance of blood donation. Rev. Fr. Raymond Cherubin, the vice-principal of the college, welcomed the team and emphasized the importance of blood donation among the youth.</p> <p>The initiative saw enthusiastic participation from students, parents, staff, and locals from nearby villages. J.K. Lon Hospital facilitated the setup, and all collected blood will be donated to children suffering from thalassemia. The camp was coordinated by Dr. Sunita Choudhary and Dr. Mamta Pareek from the Red Ribbon Club, alongside Dr. Ritu Mehra and Mr. Rohan Thomas Cherian from the NSS.</p> <p>Around 45 units of blood were donated at the college. 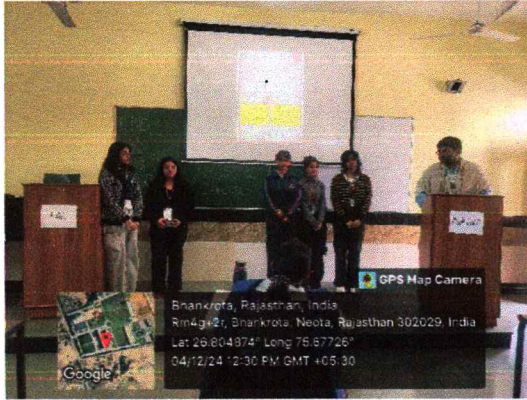

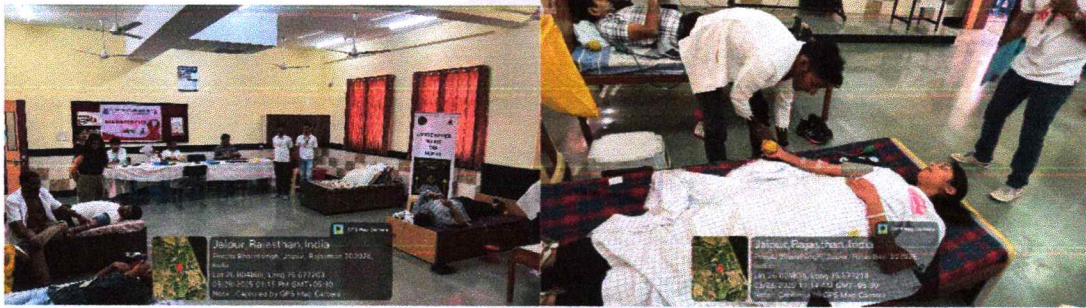
