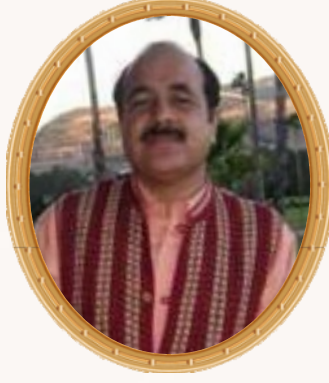
EXTENTION ACTIVITIES
