The selections of cadets are strictly supervised by the NCC Unit/Battalion. Cadets in NCC are taught and trained about Indian Defence Services (Naval). The technical, administration and social approaches are touched during the 3 years course. Every year cadets are required to undergo Annual Training Camp and several activities organised by the unit.

Shivaji, Lonavala.

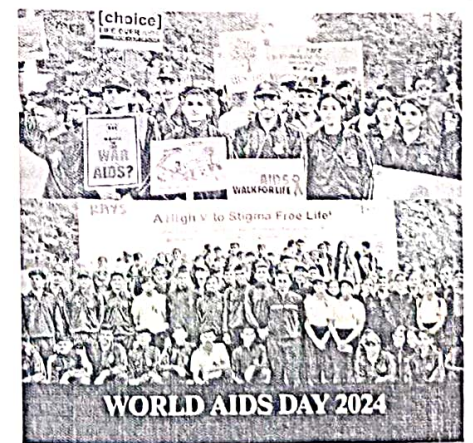
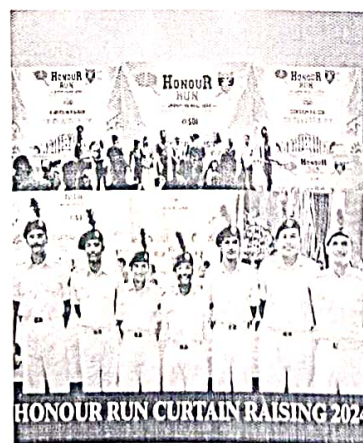
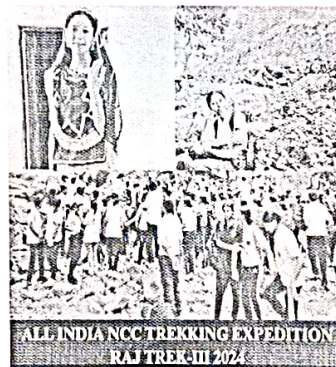
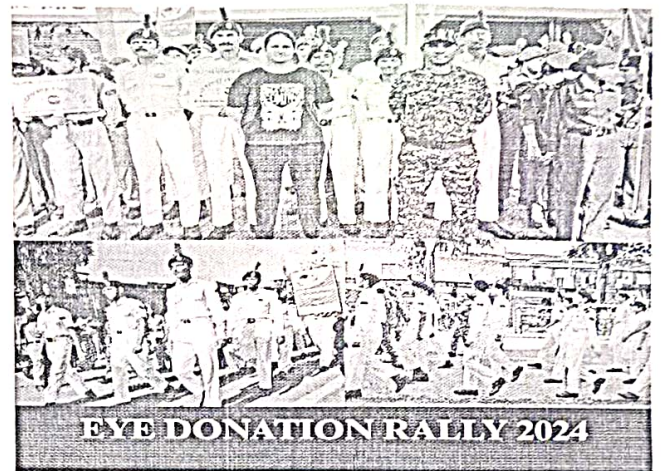
3. National Space Day in India commemorates the successful landing of Chandrayaan-3 on the Moon. It is celebrated on 23 August.

18. International Women's Day is celebrated every year on March 8 to honor the achievements, rights, and contributions of women across all spheres of life.

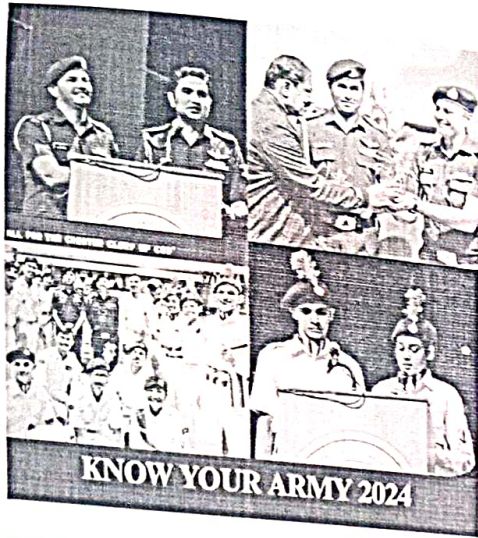
Our cadets paid tribute to all the women and celebrated their victories with happiness and honor.

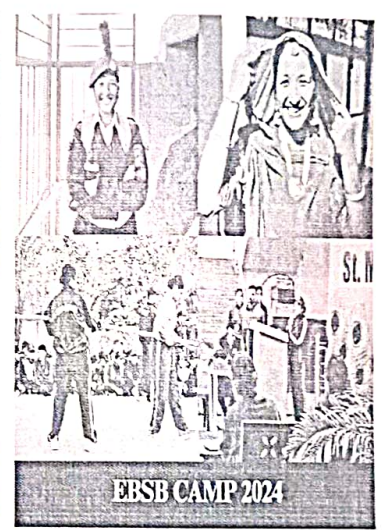
