Prime Minister Internship Scheme (PMIS) Registration of Eligible Students

Students are hereby informed about the **Prime Minister Internship Scheme (PMIS) – Pilot Project**, launched by the **Ministry of Corporate Affairs, Government of India**, with the objective of providing youth with practical exposure and internship opportunities in leading companies and organisations. The scheme aims to bridge the gap between academic learning and industry requirements and enhance students' employability.

Eligibility

Students are advised to check their eligibility carefully before registering. As per the guidelines:

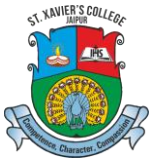
- Applicant must be an **Indian citizen** aged **18–25 years** as on the date of application.
- Applicant should not be in full-time employment.
- Eligible qualifications include **B.A., B.Sc., B.Com., BCA, BBA, B.Pharm, B.E./B.Tech and other specified undergraduate qualifications**, as well as **M.A., M.Sc., M.Com, MCA, M.Tech and other specified postgraduate qualifications**.
- Students enrolled in **online/distance learning programmes** are eligible.
- **Final-year students of full-time graduation/post-graduation programmes are also eligible**, subject to the prescribed conditions.
- Final-year students are required to submit an **NOC from their educational institution** during the application process, confirming that participation will not affect their academic requirements.

Students falling under the specified ineligibility criteria, including those with certain qualifications such as **MBA/CA/CMA/CS/MBBS/BDS/MD/MS/M.Phil/PhD**, or those meeting other exclusion conditions prescribed under the scheme, should not apply.

Registration & Application

Eligible students are advised to:

1. Register on the **PM Internship Portal** through the prescribed Aadhaar authentication/e-KYC process.
2. Complete their personal, educational and contact details.
3. Upload the required educational qualification/certification documents.
4. Complete the required self-declaration regarding eligibility.
5. Browse available internship opportunities based on **sector, functional role, location and qualification**.
6. Apply for suitable internship opportunities as per their preferences.

Important Information

Under the extended Pilot Project, internships may be for **6 or 9 months**, depending on the nature of the internship, sector and company requirements. At least half of the internship period is required to be spent in an actual working/real-life business environment.

The scheme provides **monthly assistance of ₹9,000**, comprising ₹900 from the participating company and ₹8,100 from the Government through Direct Benefit Transfer, subject to the prescribed conditions. A **one-time incidental grant of ₹6,000** is also provided in two tranches of ₹3,000 each.

Students are encouraged to **register on the PM Internship Portal**, explore suitable opportunities, and use this platform to gain practical industry exposure, develop professional skills, and enhance employability.
