Objectives

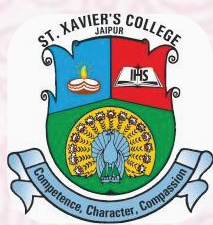

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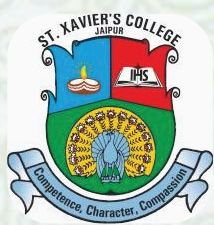
RANGOLI COMPETITION

Rules and Regulations

Samraksha – Care for Common Earth

1. Team Size: Each team must consist of a minimum of 4 members and a maximum of 5 members.
2. Department Participation: Each department can register only one team for the competition.
3. Theme-Based Rangoli: The Rangoli must be created strictly according to the given theme.
4. Designated Area: Participants must create their Rangoli only within the area provided by the organizers.
(Area - 35 x 47 in/ 90x120cm)
5. Time Limit: The total time allotted for completing the Rangoli is **45 minutes**. No extra time will be provided.
6. Originality & Creativity: The Rangoli should be original, creative, and innovative. Designs copied directly from existing sources may lead to disqualification.
7. Cleanliness & Discipline: Participants must maintain cleanliness and discipline throughout the competition and clean their designated area after completion. Any damage or mess caused to the venue may lead to disqualification.

NOTE: Colours & Materials: Participants must bring their own Rangoli colours and materials, including flowers, leaves, pulses, grains, seeds, coloured salt, sawdust, spices, sand, dried flowers/leaves and other eco-friendly decorative items; **the organizers will not provide any materials.**



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QUIZ COMPETITION

Rules and Regulations

ROUND 1 – PRELIMINARY ROUND

Each participating team will be asked two questions.

Each team will be given 15 seconds to answer each question.

A correct answer carries 20 marks.

Prompting, discussion with the audience, or the use of any unfair means will lead to immediate disqualification.

Questions that are unanswered or answered incorrectly will be passed to the audience at the end of the round.

ROUND 2 – RAPID FIRE ROUND

The question set will be selected by picking a chit.

Each set will consist of five questions.

Teams will have 10 seconds to answer each question. The buzzer will indicate the end of the 10-second answering time.

Each correct answer carries 10 marks.

If a team wishes to decline a question, the participant must clearly say "PASS."

ROUND 3 – TIMED QUESTION ROUND

This is a Written Question Round.

Each team will be provided with a hardcopy of the questions to be attempted during the round.

The team must attempt all the questions within the fixed time allotted for the round.

The completion of the allotted time will be indicated by a buzzer sound. Teams must stop writing immediately upon hearing the buzzer.

A negative marking of 5 marks will be applied for:

An incorrect answer, or Attempting or continuing to answer after the allotted time has ended.

Questions that remain unanswered at the end of the allotted time will be treated as unattempted and will not be passed to the audience.

The detailed format and instructions of this round will be disclosed to the participants at the time of the event.

TIE-BREAKER

In the event of a tie between two or more teams, a Tie-Breaker Round will be conducted to determine the winner.

REEL SPECIFICATIONS

THEME- **The Secret Life of SXCJ Campus Flora**

Time for preparing the reel: **45 minutes**; Duration of the Reel: **2 minutes**

FORMAT- **Vertical 9:16.**

The reel must be original and created for the competition. Ensure good-quality visuals, audio and editing.

JUDGING CRITERIA

Creativity & Originality — Innovation and uniqueness of concept.

Ecological Message — Clarity and relevance of the message.

Storytelling — Narrative, concept and engagement.

Technical Quality — Visuals, audio and editing.

Overall Impact — Ability to engage and inspire.

SUBMISSION

Submit the final reel through the official submission channel **sap.sxcj@sxcjpr.edu.in** before the announced deadline.

File format should be in **MP4** and submission requirements must be followed as communicated by the organisers.

Late or incomplete submissions may not be accepted. Only the final submitted version will be considered for judging.

Accuracy of Information-Correctness of plant-related facts and uses

Storytelling — Narrative, concept and engagement.

Technical Quality — Visuals, audio and editing.

Overall Impact — Ability to engage and inspire.

GENERAL RULES

5 participants per department is permitted. Each department can register only **one team** for the competition.

The organisers may reject or disqualify entries that violate the rules.

Reels will be displayed during the event for judgement.

The students must be featured in the videos, and AI can only be used to search for information about the plant, its uses and any other relevant information

IMPORTANT

By submitting an entry, participants confirm that the content is their own or that they have the necessary permissions to use all third-party material included in the reel.

The decision of the judges and organisers shall be final and binding.
