The **Teach For India Fellowship** is a **full-time, two-year commitment** that offers young graduates an opportunity to work directly in schools and communities while contributing towards educational equity.

Key Details:

- **Role:** Teach For India Fellowship – Full-time, 2-year commitment
- **Locations:** Ahmedabad, Bengaluru, Chennai, Delhi, Gurgaon, Hyderabad, Kolkata, Mumbai and Pune
- **CTC:** ₹3.6 LPA to ₹5.1 LPA
- **Monthly Stipend:** ₹30,000 gross
- **City Compensatory Allowance:** ₹6,000–₹12,600 on relocation
- **Additional Benefits:** Reimbursement of classroom-related expenses and medical insurance of ₹2 lakh
- **Eligibility:** Final-year undergraduate/postgraduate/PhD students who will have a bachelor's degree in any discipline by June 2027
